3           **WHEREAS, Bradley A. Hokanson (Brad) is celebrating his retirement with his**  
4 **wife, Susan; and their five (5) wonderful children and ten (10) grandchildren; and**

1           **WHEREAS**, Brad is originally from Brunswick, Maine, and has lived on  
2 Guam since 1984; and

3           **WHEREAS**, Brad served in the United States Coast Guard (USCG) for twenty  
4 (20) years and retired as a Chief Machinery Technician in 1990. His assignments  
5 included serving on a High Endurance Cutter in Vietnam; Loran Stations in Yap and  
6 Palau; Buoy Tenders in San Francisco and Guam; and small boat search and rescues  
7 in Portland, Maine, and San Francisco, including two (2) deployments to Antarctica,  
8 to name a few; and

9           **WHEREAS**, Brad attended the USCG Chief Petty Officers Academy in May  
10 1989; he graduated from the Guam Police Academy in May 1991; and he received his  
11 Associates of Science Degree in Law Enforcement Administration from the Guam  
12 Community College in 1998; and

13           **WHEREAS**, Brad was the Government of Guam's Interoperable  
14 Communications Coordinator, and a Program Coordinator IV responsible for  
15 management of the Government of Guam's Public Safety Radio Communication  
16 System and emergency radio communications. He has been serving with the Guam  
17 Police Department (GPD) for the past twenty-six (26) years, and was detailed to  
18 Guam Homeland Security for six (6) years; and

19           **WHEREAS**, Brad was appointed to the Department of Homeland Security  
20 (DHS) sponsored SAFECOM Emergency Response Council in 2014. He was the  
21 Program Manager for the 2007 Public Safety Interoperable Communications grant  
22 program that provided Guam with 2.6 Million Dollars in emergency and public safety  
23 communication improvements; and

24           **WHEREAS**, Brad was Guam's Boating Law Administrator for eighteen (18)  
25 years. He was the President of the Western States Boating Administrators Association

1 from 1999 to 2000; and he also served on the Executive Board of the National  
2 Association of State Boating Law Administrators during the same period; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Brad served at the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) as a  
4 grant peer reviewer for both communications-related and state homeland security  
5 grant programs. He also was a peer reviewer for the Tactical Interoperable  
6 Communication Plan in the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and in  
7 Jacksonville, Florida; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Brad was awarded with the GPD “Civilian of the Year” Award in  
9 2005. He had also received the GPD Meritorious Service, Distinguished Service and  
10 Meritorious Unit Awards, the Governor’s Excel Award, and the “Citizen Award for  
11 Exceptional Service” during his career with the Guam Police Department; and

12 **WHEREAS**, being a member of the Airplane Owners & Pilots Association  
13 (AOPA), the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA), and the American Radio  
14 Relay League (ARRL), Brad will continue enjoying his hobbies of flying and ham  
15 radio; and most especially spending more quality time with his entire family; now  
16 therefore, be it

26 the same be thereafter transmitted to Bradley A. Hokanson; to Chief Joseph I. Cruz,


