1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** the *Agat* Guamerica Lions Club (AGLC) - District 204 was
4 chartered in 1992 under the direction of President L. Leonor Guyos; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the *Agat* Guamerica Lions Club - District 204 is part of one of the
2 world's largest service organizations, the International Association of Lions Clubs, who
3 has forty-six thousand (46,000) clubs and over 1.4 million members, whose mission is
4 "to empower volunteers to serve their communities, meet humanitarian needs,
5 encourage peace and promote international understanding through Lions clubs"; and
6 whose vision is "to be the global leader in community and humanitarian service"; and

7 **WHEREAS**, just three (3) years after the founding of the Association of Lions
8 Club in 1917, the Lions Club became an international organization when the first clubs
9 were established in Canada; and Mexico followed in 1927. In the 1950s and 1960s
10 international growth accelerated, with new clubs in Europe, Asia and Africa; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in 1925, through the advocating of Helen Keller, Lions Club
12 International became the "knights of the blind in the crusade against darkness"; and
13 since then they have worked tirelessly to aid the blind and visually impaired; and

14 **WHEREAS**, in 1990, the Lions launched "SightFirst" restoring sight and
15 preventing blindness on a global scale; and the Lions have raised more than Three
16 Hundred Forty-Six Million Dollars for this initiative. SightFirst targets the major causes
17 of blindness - cataract, trachoma, river blindness, childhood blindness, diabetic
18 retinopathy and glaucoma; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the Lions Club International extends its mission of service every
20 day to local communities in all corners of the globe. The needs are great and its services
21 abroad include sight, health, youth, elderly, the environment and disaster relief. Its
22 international network has grown to include over two hundred (200) countries and
23 geographical areas; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the purpose of the Lions Club International is to organize, charter
25 and supervise service clubs to be known as Lions Clubs; to coordinate the activities and
26 standardize the administration of Lions Clubs; to create and foster a spirit of




1 understanding among the peoples of the world; to promote the principles of good
2 government and good citizenship; to take an active interest in the civic, cultural, social
3 and moral welfare of the community; to unite the Clubs in the bonds of friendship, good
4 fellowship and mutual understanding; to provide a forum for the open discussion of all
5 matters of public interest, provided, however, that partisan politics and sectarian
6 religion shall not be debated by Club members; to encourage service-minded people to
7 serve their community without personal financial reward; and to encourage efficiency
8 and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works
9 and private endeavors; and

10 **WHEREAS**, this year, the *Agat* Guamerica Lions Club - District 204
11 commemorates twenty-four (24) years of volunteerism and humanitarian service with a
12 celebration to be held on March 19, 2016, honoring this milestone, and that coincides
13 with the on-going preparations for the 12th Annual Festival of Pacific Arts. This year's
14 theme: "*Cultural Crossroads; Celebrating Service and Shared Identity*" challenges
15 individuals and groups representing various government, private, civic and business
16 organizations in its evening competition for the best cultural representation of any of
17 the twenty-seven (27) participating island nations. Proceeds from this celebration event
18 will benefit the recipient charities and advocacies of the AGLC- District 204, such as
19 social services and youth development; now therefore, be it

20 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
21 *Lihe slaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihe slaturan Guåhan* and the people
22 of Guam, recognize and congratulate the *Agat* Guamerica Lions Club (AGLC) - District
23 204 on the occasion of its Twenty-Fourth (24th) Year Anniversary; and does further
24 extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to the AGLC - District 204 for its many years
25 of volunteerism and humanitarian service to the people of our island and regional
26 community; and be it further
