1 **WHEREAS**, Mercy celebrates this special occasion with her husband, Mr.
2 Romeo M. Garrido, along with their five (5) children: Weena Garrido Abayon, Rayvic
3 S. Garrido, Romer S. Garrido, Lorgie Rose S. Garrido, and Romeo Junior S. Garrido;
4 and their nine (9) grandchildren: Savannah Garrido, Josiah Garrido, Prairie Garrido,
5 Michael Abayon, Nicholai Abayon, Mikaila Abayon, Kassandra Abayon, Madison
6 Garrido, and Hailey Garrido; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mercy attended Baluarte Elementary School, Iloilo City High
8 School, and Central Philippine University, which are all located in Iloilo City,

10 **WHEREAS**, on August 19, 1991, Mercy started her government of Guam
11 service working as a Nutrition Assistant with the Department of Public Health and
12 Social Services (DPHSS), where she began her journey in devoting herself to helping
13 others in the community. She was promoted to the position of Nutrition Assistant I on
14 December 30, 2003, and resigned from that position on March 30, 2016; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Mercy has received numerous recognition and service awards,
16 such as a Certificate of Five (5) Years' Service Award, a Certificate of Ten (10) Years'
17 Service Award, a Certificate of Fifteen (15) Years' Service Award, and a Certificate of

19 her services while serving in the WIC program, which is a special supplemental
20 nutrition and education program for women, infants, and children up to five (5) years
21 old. Although it is a federally funded program, WIC is a health promotion program,
22 not welfare. It teaches families to be aware of their nutritional needs and to practice
23 good eating habits, which helps them to be healthy during times of rapid growth; and
24 it also promotes and supports breastfeeding, which helps to lower health costs; and

25 **WHEREAS**, when Mercy is not working, she loves spending time with her
26 friends and family, attending aerobics classes at the *Dededo* Community Center,

1 dinning out with friends, dancing, and relaxing at the Tree Bar of the Guam Hilton
2 Resort and Spa, as well as cooking and sharing food with her co-workers; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mercy has also shared her talents and treasures while serving as a
4 volunteer at the Guam Memorial Hospital Cafeteria; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mercy is looking forward to traveling the world with her husband
6 and family, managing her property in Guimaras Island, which has a mango plantation;
7 and just enjoying a healthy lifestyle; now therefore, be it
