- 2 MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:
- WHEREAS, Joseph Baza Mendiola is celebrating his retirement with his wife
- 4 of thirty-five (35) years, Nacrina; their three (3) children: Jodeen Mendiola, Jorome

- 1 Mendiola, and Johana Mendiola; and their two (2) wonderful grandchildren: Mercedes
- 2 Cruz and Francisco Mendiola; and
- WHEREAS, Joseph Baza Mendiola is the son of †Jose Cruz Mendiola
- 4 (Familian Potput) and †Julia Baza Mendiola (familian Santiago/Tito). He is the
- 5 grandson of †Ignacio Cruz Mendiola and †Maria Cruz Mendiola; and †Ramon Sablan
- 6 Baza (*Tito*) and †Rosa Cruz Baza (*Santiago*); and
- WHEREAS, Joseph began his public service career in 1974, working as a
- 8 legislative staff for the late Honorable †Senator Richard Taitano. During this time, he
- 9 began coaching for the *Yona* Redhawks, and he was selected to coach the Southern
- 10 Little League All-Stars, who went on to represent Guam in the Far East Little League
- 11 Tournament, which was hosted on Guam in 1976; and
- WHEREAS, in 1976 and 1977, Joseph was the coach of the St. Francis
- 13 School's boys' basketball and volleyball teams and the girls' volleyball and softball
- teams. He then went on to coach Notre Dame High School's volleyball, softball, and
- basketball teams in 1977; and
- WHEREAS, in 1978 Joseph continued in his government of Guam career and
- began working with the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR), where he served
- as a recreation leader and was, responsible for the youth activities and programs for
- 19 the Yona Youth Center. In the mid 1980's, as a result of his hard work and dedication
- 20 to the youth and young adults in the village of Yona, the late Honorable †Mayor
- Vicente Bernardo dedicated and named the municipal park, which is comprised of the
- 22 Yona Youth Center (now known as the "Peter Mark Cruz Center"), the Yona Gym and
- the Yona softball field, as the "Joseph B. Mendiola Park"; and
- WHEREAS, Joseph had served as Commissioner of the Guam Basketball
- 25 League, which promoted varsity level competition on an island-wide basis to include
- 26 military and village men's varsity teams. He also served as Commissioner for the

- 1 Marianas Invitational Basketball tournament, which promoted youth basketball at the
- 2 Youth Center level, and ultimately included the top teams from Guam, Saipan, Tinian,
- 3 and Palau; and
- 4 WHEREAS, in 1983, Joseph was promoted to the position of Recreation
- 5 Supervisor, and his focus then became island-wide, and included the twelve (12)
- 6 youth centers in villages around the island. During his tenure with DPR, Joseph Baza
- 7 Mendiola also developed and implemented the first Island-wide Annual DPR Easter
- 8 Egg Hunt (which is still held every year); the Annual Halloween Carnival; the DPR
- 9 Youth Summer Camp; and the Government of Guam Departhalon. He also
- 10 collaborated with various organizations and planned the First Marianas Homegrown
- 11 Concert which was held in the village of *Yona*; and
- WHEREAS, Joseph managed and maintained various recreational facilities,
- including the *Paseo* Stadium, the Jose Guerrero softball field and the *Tiyan* fields; as
- well as the *Hagåtña* Pool, *Ypao* Beach and *Matåpang* Beach; and
- 15 WHEREAS, after serving in various subsequent acting capacities, which
- included oversight of the island-wide parks, the Veterans Cemetery maintenance, and
- 17 the Park Ranger operations, Joseph was ultimately promoted to the position of
- 18 Recreation Administrator in 2010, additionally giving him oversight over community
- 19 programs and the *Dededo* Sports Complex. He also promoted sports tourism,
- 20 collaborating with Japanese and Korean professional baseball teams; and
- WHEREAS, as the department was faced with austere budget practices and
- 22 manpower challenges, Joseph administered external special programs to supplement
- 23 such shortfalls AHRD clients for typhoon projects; community service clients
- 24 referred by local and federal courts; and senior citizen contractual referrals from the
- 25 Guam Visitors Bureau and the Department of Labor; and

WHEREAS, Joseph Baza Mendiola is an ardent advocate of those with disabilities, as he has been blessed with a special needs child; and he has focused his advocacy towards acceptance and inclusion of individuals with disabilities. He is a founding and lifetime member of the Down Syndrome Association of Guam, which has been in existence since 2001. He is also a founding member of Guam Positive Parents Together. He has served in various capacities in numerous advocacy groups, such as the Center for Excellence in Developmental Disabilities Education, Research and Service (CEDDARS); the Guam Disability Development Council (DDC); and the Guam Interagency Coordinating Council. This is a testament to his desire to champion the rights of individuals with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, throughout his career Joseph Baza Mendiola has received numerous awards and commendations for his hard work and dedication, and he will be fondly remembered for all his accomplishments; and

WHEREAS, after his retirement, Joseph Baza Mendiola plans to continue his service to the people of the beautiful village *Yona*, his advocacy for individuals with disabilities, his love for sports, and most especially, his dedication to spending quality time with his family; now therefore, be it
