**Relative to recognizing and congratulating Mr. and Mrs. Arthur and Zenaida Zantua on the occasion of the Nineteenth (19th) Year Anniversary of their New Fresh Bread Bakeshop, and on the Grand Opening of their second New Fresh Bread Bakeshop and Nature's Fresh Water Station locations, and their first coffee shop, Café Panadero; and to further extending a sincere *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to the Zantuas and their family and staff for their continued commitment and dedication to the economic development of Guam.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Arthur and Zenaida Zantua, both of which have a love**  
4 **for food, became not just business partners in owning and running the New Fresh Bread**

1 Bakeshop and Nature's Fresh Water Station, and a convenient store together, but also  
2 became life partners as they tied the knot in marriage in 2009; and

3 **WHEREAS**, at the age of ten (10) years old, Arthur Zantua had an early start in the  
4 food business by selling Pandesal, a Filipino bread roll, on the streets of Manila,  
5 Philippines, where he grew up. Every morning on his way to school, Arthur would pick  
6 up a box of Pandesal from a neighborhood bakeshop, divide up the rolls and hand deliver  
7 them to the doors of his customers. He recalls putting the bread into plastic bags and  
8 would hang the bags on their front door or on their gate and collect payment at the end of  
9 the week from clients; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in 2003, Zenaida Zantua was already an established business owner on  
11 Guam. Zenaida was given a chance to open her first bakery, which was named the Bread  
12 and Butter Bakeshop, but later decided to open the doors of the New Fresh Bread  
13 Bakeshop for the first time in the village of *Dededo*, which gained the attention of the  
14 local Filipino community with its Filipino breads and pastries. The most popular items at  
15 the *Dededo* bakery are the Filipino breads: Pandesal, Pan de Coco, and Pan de Ube; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the New Fresh Bread Bakeshop bakeries employ fifty-two (52)  
17 workers, with the majority of them working at the *Dededo* bakery. Of the fifty-two (52)  
18 employees, twenty-one (21) have been with the Zantuas since the business opened.  
19 Arthur says, some of the children of those original workers are now working in the  
20 bakery and have remained loyal because they're treated like family; and

21 **WHEREAS**, for the first-time visitors to the New Fresh Bread Bakeshop, Arthur  
22 recommends trying the cream cheese rolls, the French macarons, the young coconut and  
23 taro-flavored cake rolls, and the Sans Rival, which is a Filipino dessert cake with a bit of  
24 a crunch that's made of layers of butter cream, meringue and chopped cashews; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the New Fresh Bread Bakeshop location in *Yigo* also features Café  
26 Panadero, a coffee shop where patrons can sit down to have a drink and to dine on items  
27 purchased from the bakery and café which offers hot breakfast and lunch plates, with  
28 menus that change daily, and an a la carte menu featuring a variety of pasta dishes that

1 are always available, a dining area, and a Mini Mart that stocks a variety of dry and  
2 frozen Filipino goods, and creates customized cakes for weddings and special occasions;  
3 and

4 **WHEREAS**, the Zantuas are also celebrating the grand opening of their water  
5 station called, Nature's Fresh Water Station and Mini Mart, which aims to change the  
6 way its customers are serviced with an ultra-convenient drive-thru service. Just like all  
7 drive-thru restaurants, it will have a motion-activated camera at the back entrance which  
8 alerts the water station attendees when a customer has arrived for service. Arthur says the  
9 drive-thru service is especially convenient for parents who have kids in the car, and for  
10 individuals with a disability; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Nature's Fresh Water is powered by a state of the art commercial  
12 water treatment system by Culligan which handles the water purification process from  
13 carbon filtration and reverse osmosis to deionization and water softening. A single knob  
14 system makes refilling water containers simple and quick, and replenished bottles are  
15 sealed with spill-proof hot sleeves. It also offers a commercial water delivery service for  
16 island businesses; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Mini Mart's shelves are lined with a wide selection of Filipino  
18 snacks, including popular Filipino crackers, peanuts, corn nuts, chips, candies and  
19 chocolates, as they want to fill a need for the Filipino community; and they also carry  
20 items from the Philippines that local Filipinos are always looking for, such as marinated  
21 milk fish, tocino, and a variety of snacks; and


22 **WHEREAS**, the Mini Mart also stocks up on boneless bangus belly, tiny herring  
23 and other fish, a selection of Filipino canned goods, cooking sauces, and tea. Arthur says  
24 that they're going for the ambiance that feels like a shop in the Philippines that the  
25 Filipino customers are familiar with; and so people from other cultures that aren't  
26 familiar can experience just that; and


1           **WHEREAS**, from their humble beginnings to becoming business owners, the  
2 Zantuas hope their story will inspire other Filipino contract workers to never give up and  
3 to pursue their dreams; now therefore, be it


4           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan*
