Eisenhower, and it was reaffirmed through a Joint Resolution by the 5 6 members of the U.S. Congress in 1961; and WHEREAS, "Law Day" is celebrated annually on May 1st as a special day of 7 8 celebration by the people of Guam and the nation, to join in the appreciation of every 9 citizen's liberties, and to provide a unique time for reflection and dedication of the 10 ideals of equality and justice for all under the laws of the land; and WHEREAS, this year's theme of "Law Week" is "Miranda: More than 11 Words" as 2016 marks the fiftieth (50th) year anniversary of a milestone in legal 12 13 history, perhaps the nation's best-known United States Supreme Court case, Miranda vs. Arizona; and 14 15 WHEREAS, this year's theme will explore the procedural protections afforded 16 to all of us by the U.S. Constitution, how these rights are shielded by the courts, and 17 why the preservation of these principles is essential to our liberty; and 18 WHEREAS, the Miranda Warning has become ingrained in law enforcement 19 and has become one of the nation's most recognizable legal expressions and a symbol 20 of procedural fairness that represents much more than just the words of warning; and
