1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** since its founding in June of 1917, the Lions Clubs International has
4 grown to be the world's largest service club organization with forty-six thousand (46,000)

1 clubs, and over one million four hundred thousand (1,400,000) members in over two hundred
2 (200) countries and geographical areas; and

3 **WHEREAS**, a description of the work of Lions Clubs is encapsulated in the Lions
4 Clubs International Mission Statement: “To empower volunteers to serve their communities,
5 meet humanitarian needs, encourage peace and promote international understanding through
6 Lions Clubs”; and its Vision Statement: “To be the global leader in community and
7 humanitarian service”; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Lions Clubs International District 204 comprises twenty-two (22) Lions
9 Clubs in Guam, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, Chuuk State and Yap
10 State in the Federated States of Micronesia, the Republic of Palau, and the Republic of the
11 Marshall Islands, under the leadership of District Governor Daniel Yang and his cabinet
12 officers; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Lions Clubs of District 204 have been true to the organization’s
14 mission through various community improvement projects, such as sight conservation,
15 hearing preservation, youth outreach, environmental protection, diabetes and cancer
16 awareness, and aid to the sick and elderly; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Lions Clubs International District 204 clubs on Guam have long
18 been a tremendous asset to our island and have contributed greatly to our community’s
19 development and improvement; and

20 **WHEREAS**, on April 23, 2016, the Lions Clubs International District 204 clubs on
21 Guam will engage in one of their biggest events, Lions Worldwide Induction Day, by
22 celebrating the induction of new members into their respective clubs; and

23 **WHEREAS**, in its celebration of Worldwide Induction Day, the Lions Clubs
24 International District 204 welcome new members, recognize their commitment to service as
25 a Lion, share in the pride of what it means to be a Lion, and underscore the importance of
26 getting involved in community improvement and helping those in need; now therefore, be it

2 *Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, recognize
3 and commend the Lions Clubs of Lions Clubs International District 204 for their service and

5 them on the celebration of Lions Worldwide Induction Day; and does further congratulate
6 the new inductees into their respective Lions Clubs; and be it further

11 *Maga'låhen Guåhan*.


