**Relative to recognizing, memorializing, and distinguishing the life and work of Segundo “Sy” Unpingco and his stellar service and contributions to the *Chamorro* Golf Community in the state of California; and to further extending *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to the Directors and Members of the *Hafa Adai* Golf Classic organization for their diligence in keeping the annual golf tournaments alive, and for continuing to promote goodwill and fellowship among all its participants.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2           ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN*:**

3           **WHEREAS**, the late †Segundo “Sy” Unpingco was born on May 23, 1934; and  
4           he graduated from George Washington High School in 1954. At the young age of

1 eighteen (18) years old, Sy met his wife Remmy and married her in 1953, while still in  
2 high school; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Segundo “Sy” Unpingco and his wife Remmy were married for  
4 sixty-two (62) years, and were blessed with three (3) children: a daughter Vivian, and  
5 two (2) sons, Cy and Paul; and were also blessed with four (4) grandchildren and eight  
6 (8) great grandchildren; and

7 **WHEREAS**, after graduating from high school, Segundo “Sy” Unpingco left  
8 Guam and went to the United States to pursue a college degree in law in San Jose,  
9 California. He graduated with a degree in Administration of Justice, a Bachelor of  
10 Science in Business Management, and a Juris Doctor; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in 1978, Segundo “Sy” Unpingco founded a non-profit  
12 organization called the *Chamorro* Golf Club of Northern California; and served as its  
13 first Chairman of the Board. Along with Mac Sablan, Tony Chargualaf and Frank  
14 Shimizu, Sy co-founded the *Hafa Adai* Golf Classic, which is now an annual golf  
15 tournament, and served as its first Chairman of the Board as well, from 1982 to 2006;  
16 and

17 **WHEREAS**, in 1982, the First Annual *Hafa Adai* Golf Classic Tournament was  
18 held at the Suniol Golf Course and Country Club in San Jose, California; and many of  
19 his friends from Guam, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI),  
20 and other parts of the country attended; and

21 **WHEREAS**, with their vision, they opened the doors for any *Chamorro* golf  
22 club in the state of California who was willing to host the annual *Chamorro* golf  
23 tournament under the guidelines and title of the “*Hafa Adai* Golf Classic.” At one time  
24 there were nine (9) hosting golf clubs; and today there are six (6) active clubs - four  
25 (4) in the state of California: the *Todo Fino* of Southern California, the *Chamorro*

1 Golf Club of San Diego (formerly the Marianas Golf Club of San Diego), the Hazard  
2 Busters Islanders Golf Club of Sacramento (formerly the Hazard Busters of  
3 Sacramento), the *Para* Golf Club of Northern California, and the *Chamorro* Golf Club  
4 of Northern California; one (1) in the state of Washington: the *Chamorro* Golf Club of  
5 Washington State (which was founded in 1993); and one (1) in Las Vegas, Nevada:  
6 the *Guåhan* Las Vegas Golf Club of Nevada State; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the success of the *Hafa Adai* Golf Classic is attributed to Segundo  
8 “Sy” Unpingco’s vision, patience, leadership, devotion, camaraderie, understanding,  
9 love and respect for his *Chamorro* culture, friends, and family; and

10 **WHEREAS**, by 2015, *Chamorro* golfers were coming to attend the Classic, not  
11 only from around the United States, but also golfers from outside the U.S. came; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Segundo “Sy” Unpingco passed away on November 26, 2015; and  
13 he will be recognized and honored at the 35<sup>th</sup> *Hafa Adai* Golf Classic 2016 to be held  
14 from April 27 to April 29, 2016, at the Palm Valley and Highland Falls Golf Course in  
15 Summerlin, Las Vegas, Nevada; now therefore, be it

16 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*  
17 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
18 of Guam, recognize, memorialize, and distinguish the life and work of the late Segundo  
19 “Sy” Unpingco and his stellar service and contributions to the *Chamorro* golf  
20 community in the state of California; and does further extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os*  
21 *Ma'åse* to the Directors and Members of the *Hafa Adai* Golf Classic organization for  
22 their diligence in keeping the annual golf tournaments alive, and for continuing to  
23 promote goodwill and fellowship among all its participants; and be it further

24 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules  
25 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of


1 the same be thereafter transmitted to the family of the late Segundo “Sy” Unpingco; to
