- 4 States Navy since her enlistment in November 1994; and

1 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Overfield had served as a Hospital Corpsman until her 2 commissioning in July 2010; and WHEREAS, Lieutenant Overfield has served on various tours throughout the U.S. 3 4 Navy landscape, to include serving at the U.S. Naval Hospital-Guam from 2004 to 2008 as 5 a Hospital Corpsman Second Class; and again from June 2013 to June 2016 as Head of the 6 Patient Administration Department; and 7 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Overfield supervised two (2) officers, sixty (60) enlisted, 8 sixteen (16) civil service, and eight (8) contract employees to carry out eight (8) major 9 programs. Despite significant staffing shortages and staffing instability, she achieved high 10 impact results and improvements throughout the department, the command, and the U.S. 11 Navy; and 12 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Overfield managed to promote, a record setting, six (6) 13 civilians to their current pay grades.
