1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'TRENTAI***  
2           ***TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN*:**

3           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Baby Jo Marie Manglona Naputi, known to her family and friends as  
4           “Bejay,” was born February 12, 1973, to †Juan Toves Naputi and Josephine Manglona  
5           Naputi. She was raised by †Ignacio Quitugua Meno and †Maria Mantanona Meno, whom  
6           she fondly calls “her parents”; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Bejay is blessed with brothers and sisters and their spouses: Annette  
8           Naputi and Doening Arceo; Christine Naputi and Darold Cruz; John Harold Naputi; Valerie  
9           Naputi and John Paul Duenas; Maryann M. and †Pedro C. Crisostomo; †Cecilio James and

1 Agnes Q. Meno; Linda Rose and Jesse Aguon; †Ignacio Jr. and Bernadit D. Meno; Charles  
2 Roy and Rosalind L. Meno; Geraldine M. and Frankie Nauta; Vivian M. and Siaosi Furen;  
3 Jesse John and Angie A. Meno; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Bejay, attended *Inarajan* Elementary School and St. Francis School in  
5 *Yona*, and graduated from *Inarajan* High School in 1991. She received her First Holy  
6 Communion at St. Francis Church, *Yona*, and her Confirmation at San Isidro Church,  
7 *Malojloj*, in 1990. She is currently a full-time employee at the Department of Education,  
8 where she started in 1992 as an on-call substitute teacher and later in 2000, became a school  
9 aide. Bejay is now working as a Clerk Typist II. She also served as a member of the *Inarajan*  
10 Municipal Planning Council from 2004 to 2012, during the tenure of former Mayor Franklin  
11 M. Taitague; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Bejay began her parish ministries in San Isidro Church in 1989 as  
13 assistant director with Ms. Zina Ruiz, the Director of Religious Education. In 1990, she  
14 participated in the Youth Mentor for Young Christian Lifers (YCL), until 1993, when she  
15 became a Catechist for all grade levels. In 1999, Bejay and youths from the San Isidro parish  
16 formed a group called, “San Isidro Youth Group”. The group’s talent brings a sense of  
17 excitement, lifting the spirits of parish members; and

18 **WHEREAS**, in 2000, Bejay and village youths established the San Isidro Angelic  
19 Harvesters (SIAH) Youth group consisting of Confirmation Catechists and other classes.  
20 From 2005 to 2010, Bejay participated in the “Raise the Roof” fundraiser project for the  
21 church, assisted in CCD Class, and became a Confirmation Catechist from 2008 to present.  
22 She also helped organized the Annual Archdiocesan 2011 World Youth Day in *Malojloj*  
23 sponsored by the San Isidro Parish; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Bejay’s love and great devotion to her faith demonstrates her active  
25 participation in the church and village events. Her hobby is playing volleyball. She faithfully  
26 serves God and the Parish of San Isidro, *Malojloj*, and she has held various offices with the  
27 San Isidro Parish Council from 1996 to 2013. Bejay is an active choir member. She helps  
28 prepare the “*Korosa*” for the yearly street procession, organizes the youths and the logistical

1 aspects for the “*Na Taotao Tuma Nao*” along with the Float Parade during which the youths  
2 carry the San Isidro Flags throughout the procession. Bejay also participates in the yearly  
3 Christmas caroling, when the church members share the baby Jesus with village  
4 parishioners; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Bejay will lead the San Isidro fiesta parade on Sunday, May 15, 2016, at  
6 3:00 p.m. as a testament to her and her family’s generous and unselfish contributions to the  
7 San Isidro church and the *Malojloj* community, as they celebrate and honor their patron  
8 saint, San Isidro; now therefore, be it

9 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan*  
10 *Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, recognize

14 further


15 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules certify,
