WHEREAS, Gracelle received her Bachelor of Science degree in Elementary 1 2 Education from the University of the Philippines, graduating cum laude in 1992; and 3 WHEREAS, for more than twenty-two (22) years during her career as an educator, Gracelle has taught all grade levels in private and public schools in the 4 5 Philippines, and made the move to the California Bay Area in 2001, where she taught at Horace Mann Elementary School in the Oakland Unified School District. She then 6 7 moved to Guam and began teaching within the Guam Department of Education at Harry S. Truman Elementary from 2011-2013; Maria Ulloa Elementary from 2013-2014; and 8 9 now teaches at Upi Elementary School; and WHEREAS, Gracelle dedicated two (2) decades of experience to the classroom, 10 11 and she continues to employ new insights and strategies that positively impact her students.
