3           **WHEREAS,** Lieutenant Colonel (LTC) Gina Diego San Nicolas, a native of  
4   Guam, is the daughter of Francisco and Virginia Diego San Nicolas, from the  
5   beautiful village of *Inarajan*; and

1           **WHEREAS**, she attended *Inarajan* Elementary, *Inarajan* Middle, and *Inarajan*  
2 High School. LTC San Nicolas is a member of the Association of the United States  
3 Army (AUSA) and the Screaming Eagle Association; and

4           **WHEREAS**, LTC San Nicolas received a Bachelor's degree in Marketing from  
5 the University of Guam in 2000, and was commissioned through the Reserve Officer  
6 Training Corps program. She furthered her education and received her Master's  
7 degree in Environmental Management from Webster University in St. Louis,  
8 Missouri; and

9           **WHEREAS**, LTC San Nicolas went on to attend the Chemical Officer Basic  
10 Course at Ft. Leonard Wood in Missouri. Her first assignment was with the 2-44<sup>th</sup> Air  
11 Defense Artillery Battalion in the 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne Division (Air Assault), Fort  
12 Campbell, Kentucky; and

13           **WHEREAS**, during Operation Iraqi Freedom I, she served in numerous  
14 capacities and roles before moving to become the Battalion Logistics Officer.  
15 Consequent to redeployment, she attended the Chemical Officer Advance Course at  
16 Fort Leonard Wood in Missouri and returned to the 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne Division (AASLT),  
17 and served in the 101<sup>st</sup> Combat Aviation Brigade, Task Force Destiny, from where she  
18 branch transferred into the Transportation Corps; and

19           **WHEREAS**, LTC San Nicolas served as a Company Commander for the  
20 Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 101<sup>st</sup> CAB (Task Force Destiny) from  
21 March 2006 – May 2009, which involved two deployments both to Iraq and  
22 Afghanistan during Operation Iraq Freedom IV with Task Force Band of Brothers and  
23 Operation Enduring Freedom IX with Combined Joint Task-101; and

24           **WHEREAS**, upon deployment, she served as the 950<sup>th</sup> Transportation  
25 Company CDR (SDDC) in Bremerhaven, Germany, serving with a variety of  
26 commercial and governmental agencies, as well as foreign militaries supporting

1 EUCOM, AFRICOM, and MARFORAF. She then moved to the 1<sup>st</sup> Cavalry Division  
2 and deployed to Afghanistan serving as the Secretary for the combined Joint Staff  
3 under Combined Joint Task Force-1 (CJTF-1) in Regional Command-East from April  
4 2011 – April 2012; and

5 **WHEREAS**, upon redeployment LTC San Nicolas then served as the Brigade  
6 Support Operations Officer (SPO) in the 1<sup>st</sup> Armored Brigade Combat Team in the 1<sup>st</sup>  
7 Cavalry Division; and

8 **WHEREAS**, she was then selected to serve as an Interagency Fellow with the  
9 United States Agency for International Development (USAID) in Washington D.C.  
10 LTC San Nicolas most recently served as the Aide-To-Camp to the 35<sup>th</sup> Vice Chief of  
11 Staff, Army; and

12 **WHEREAS**, LTC Gina Diego San Nicolas' awards and decorations include:  
13 the Meritorious Unit Citation (3 Oak Leaf Cluster) (3OLC); the Joint Meritorious Unit  
14 Citation; the the Bronze Star Medal (2OLC); the Defense Meritorious Service Medal;  
15 the Meritorious Service Medal (2OLC); the Joint Commendation Medal; the Army  
16 Commendation Medal; the Joint Service Achievement Medal (3OLC); the Iraqi  
17 Expeditionary ribbon; the Iraq Campaign Medal; the Afghanistan Campaign Medal;  
18 the NATO Medal; the German Efficiency Badge; the Pathfinder Badge; the Air  
19 Assault Badge; and the Army Staff Badge; and

21 the love and support of her family and friends. She is a very humble and loving


