1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, Sister Jeanette Marie Pangelinan was destined to be “*mercy*,” as
4 she was born on *Mercy Day*, September 24, 1948; she is the daughter of the late
5 Joaquin and Marcela Pangelinan and is one (1) of nine (9) children; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Sister Jeanette attended *Mongmong* Elementary School,
2 *Barrigada* Junior High School, and John F. Kennedy High School. It was after
3 graduating from high school that Sister Jeanette realized that the religious life was her
4 calling. She was intrigued by this life and followed her aspiration to show “*mercy*” to
5 others; and on August 22, 1966, she became a Sister of Mercy; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Sister Jeanette continued in her education and received her
7 Bachelor’s Degree in Elementary Education in 1978 from the University of Guam;
8 and her Master’s Degree in Private School Administration in 2004 from the
9 University of San Francisco; and

10 **WHEREAS**, throughout her fifty (50) years of service as a Sister of Mercy,
11 Sister Jeanette has been involved in the education ministry. She started her teaching
12 career as an educator at Saint Anthony Catholic School and Bishop Baumgartner
13 Memorial School. She is currently the Principal of Santa Barbara Catholic School and
14 has held this position since July 1997; and

15 **WHEREAS**, leading up to this grand occasion of her Golden Jubilee, Sister
16 Jeanette Marie cites “gratefulness for the gift of her vocation” as her common core.
17 “The vows she continues to live” is what inspired her to remain a Sister of Mercy and
18 a woman vowed to her faith; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Sister Jeanette commends the pledge to her vocation to her sisters
20 in community, her family and the people of God who keep her inclined. She cites her
21 accession into “*mercy*” as her most profound moment as a Sister of Mercy because she
22 entrusted in God’s grace to sustain her as she was “jumping into the unknown”; and


23 **WHEREAS**, “*mercy*” means many things to her such as: compassion, love and
24 concern for others, especially the poor, sick and uneducated. It’s an “*action*” word that
25 challenges her to serve others and share God’s love unconditionally; and

2 Sister Jeanette Marie aspires to keep the *Mercy* charisma alive and pertinent in this
3 day and age of abating membership and aging of the Sisters. She hopes that the Sisters
4 will continue to be a revelation to others to embrace this life that is a gift and a sacred
5 call to be of service to others; now therefore, be it

6 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
7 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
8 of Guam, recognize and congratulate Sister Jeanette Marie Pangelinan, RSM, on the
