1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** in 1962, President John F. Kennedy proclaimed May 15 as
4 “National Peace Officers Memorial Day,” and the calendar week in which May 15 falls

1 as “National Police Week.” Officially established by a joint resolution of the U.S.
2 Congress in 1962, “National Police Week” pays special recognition to those law
3 enforcement officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty for the safety and
4 protection of others; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Guam and the nation observed Sunday, May 15, 2016, as “Peace
6 Officers Memorial Day” in honor of law enforcement officers who, through their
7 courageous deeds, have made the ultimate sacrifice in service to their community, or
8 have become disabled in the performance of duty; and it is fitting and appropriate to
9 recognize and pay respect to the survivors of our fallen heroes; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Guam paid tribute to CO Francisco Malijan Isezaki, DOA; POI
11 John M. Santos, GPD; S/A Larry D. Wallace, DEA; POI Francisco A. Reyes, GPD;
12 PRO Helen K. Lizama, GPD; POIII Tomas M. Sablan, GPD; PRO Rudy C. Iglesias,
13 GPD; SGT Sigfred D. R. Mortera, GPD; POI Raymond S. Sanchez, GPD; POI Manuel
14 A. Aquino, GPD; LT Francisco C. Toves, GPD; COI Douglas W. Mashburn, DOC;
15 SGT Stacy E. Levay, USAF/LE; POI Eddie A. Santos, GPD; POI Francisco D.
16 Taitague, GPD, and SGT Frankie Eugene Smith GPD; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the uniformed personnel of the Guam Police Department, the Port
18 Authority of Guam Police, the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Police,
19 and other local and federal law enforcement agencies, play an essential role in
20 safeguarding the rights and freedom of the community of Guam; and

21 **WHEREAS**, it is important that all citizens know and understand the duties,
22 responsibilities, hazards and sacrifices of Guam’s law enforcement officers; and that
23 the officers of Guam’s law enforcement departments and agencies recognize their duty
24 to serve the people by safeguarding life and property, protecting them against violence
25 and disorder, and protecting the innocent against deception and the weak against
26 oppression; and

1 **WHEREAS**, every day, Guam’s law enforcement officers face the threat of
2 violence and danger. They routinely put their lives on the line to defend ours, and the
3 price of that bravery may result in injury, disability, or death; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the men and women of Guam’s law enforcement agencies
5 unceasingly provide a vital public service; and from June 3 through June 11, 2016,
6 Guam’s law enforcement agencies will be celebrating the observance of “2016 Guam
7 Police Week” with various activities in recognition of the individual and collective
8 service that law enforcement agencies provide to the people of Guam; and

9 **WHEREAS**, *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* would also like to
10 sincerely express its deepest gratitude to the family members of all our law enforcement
11 officers for their indirect service to the island of Guam in providing the necessary
12 support and encouragement to these men and women in uniform who serve and protect;
13 and

14 **WHEREAS**, let us observe and commemorate this occasion to honor all our law
15 enforcement officers, past and present, who, by their faithful and loyal devotion to their
16 responsibilities, have rendered a dedicated service to their communities and, in so doing,
17 have established for themselves an enviable and enduring reputation for preserving the
18 rights and security of all citizens; now therefore, be it

19 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
20 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
21 of Guam, recognize, honor and thank the men and women of the Guam Police
22 Department, the Port Authority of Guam Police, the A.B. Won Pat International Airport
23 Authority Police, and other local and federal law enforcement officers, for their valor
24 and outstanding service in protecting the people of our island community; and does
25 further pay tribute to them as they celebrate the observance of “2016 Guam Police
26 Week”; and be it further

1 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
2 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
3 the same be thereafter transmitted to Mr. Joseph I. Cruz, Chief of Police, Guam Police
4 Department; to Ms. Doris Aguero, Chief, Port Authority of Guam Police; to Mr. Robert
5 Camacho, Chief, A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Police; and to the
6 Honorable Edward B. Calvo, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*.
