1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2        ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN*:**

3        **WHEREAS, Mr. Romeo “Romy” A. Angel was born on May 23, 1946, in San**  
4        **Antonio, Zambales, Philippines. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Celso and Timotea**  
5        **Angel; and his siblings are Alfonso, Rosauro, Roberto and Visitacion Figuerres; and**

1           **WHEREAS**, Romy celebrates this special occasion with his wife of forty-four  
2 (44) years, Mrs. Felicitas “Fely” B. Angel; and his four (4) children and their spouses  
3 and grandchildren, including his son Rommel Christian and his wife Maria Cristina  
4 Miguel, and their children Jael Christine, Jeremy Christian and Johan Rai; his  
5 daughter Melissa Christine and her husband Adam Christian Dela Rosa, and their  
6 children Austin John and Alyssa Christine; his daughter Melynda Kristi and her  
7 husband James Lester Santiago; and his son Rowell Kristopher and his wife Jocelyn  
8 Sy, and their children Riley Jacob and Renzo Jaden; and

9           **WHEREAS**, Romy attended a private school, Teodoro R. Yangco, in Manila,  
10 Philippines, from where he received his elementary school, junior high school and  
11 senior high school education. He also received his Bachelor of Science degree in  
12 Education from Columban College in Zambales, Philippines, graduating in the Class  
13 of 1968; and

14           **WHEREAS**, after finishing college, Romy became a CCD teacher at a public  
15 school in the city of Olongapo, Philippines, where he guided the students to be more  
16 involved and focused on lifelong learning experiences, to include writing, speaking,  
17 and having an artistic expression that is appropriate for the context and audience they  
18 may be engaged in; and

19           **WHEREAS**, Romy was later hired to work at the U.S. Naval Base Subic Bay in  
20 Olongapo, where he served as the Education Services Officer and Guidance Counselor  
21 for the U.S. military personnel and U.S. dependents in Subic Bay, at Clark Air Force  
22 Base in Angeles City, and at the U.S. Naval Support Facility in Diego Garcia, at the  
23 British Indian Ocean Territory. He also served as the Bank Liaison Officer at the U.S.  
24 Naval Support Facility in Diego Garcia; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Romy and his family moved to Guam in 1991, and he began his  
2 career profession as a banker with the Bank of Guam the following year, where he  
3 started with the Training and Development Team. Romy quickly moved up the ladder  
4 and held the following positions: 1992 to 1993 - Branch Manager in Kwajalein; 1993  
5 to 1995 - Facility Manager at Naval Station; 1995 to 1996 - Assistant Branch Manager  
6 at Naval Station; 1996 - Branch Manager at the *Adelup* branch; 1996 to 1999 - Branch  
7 Manager at the *Dededo* branch; 1999 to 2001 - Branch Manager in Majuro; 2001 to  
8 2003 - Sales and Customer Service Officer in Majuro; 2003 to 2004 - Branch Manager  
9 in Majuro; 2004 to 2011 - Branch Manager, *Dededo*; 2011 to 2013 - International  
10 Remittance Officer, *Dededo*; and 2013 to the present - Branch Manager, Upper  
11 *Tumon*; and

12           **WHEREAS**, Romy is a banker by profession, garnering prestigious awards,  
13 such as the Bank of Guam President’s Award as the “Employee of the Year” in 2000,  
14 and the “Minority Small Business Champion of the Year” in 2014. Currently, he  
15 serves as the Bank of Guam Vice-President and Branch Manager, with his twenty-  
16 three (23) years of banking experience; and

17           **WHEREAS**, Romy’s efforts to assist minority small businesses go far beyond  
18 any customer’s expectations. He always maintains the relationships he has with these  
19 businesses, and his willingness to respond to their every beckon shows paramount  
20 dedication to the success of minority small businesses in the community. He has  
21 reached out to all minority groups who are in need of assistance adapting to the pace  
22 of life, traditions and business culture; and

23           **WHEREAS**, Romy is also an active officer and member of various Filipino  
24 community organizations on Guam, such as the Society of Families and Friends on

1 Guam and the Manaoag Family Association; and he was nominated for the Filipino  
2 Community of Guam's (FCG) 2015 *Gawad Ulirang Pilipino* award for the corporate  
3 economics in entrepreneur leadership. Romy is a couples leader for the Couples for  
4 Christ, Guam Chapter; the Sponsor Couples for the Marriage Encounter; Past Grand  
5 Knight and Faithful Navigator of the Knights of Columbus; Board of Directors  
6 member of the Santa Barbara Parish Finance Committee; extra-ordinary minister of  
7 the Eucharist; and Board of Directors member of the Guam Housing Corporation; and

8       **WHEREAS**, as a leader with Lions Club International, Romy participated in  
9 various seminars in Hong Kong, Thailand Taiwan, and the Philippines. His  
10 involvement within these countries has allowed him to develop a deeper  
11 understanding of their culture and meet their financial needs within Guam's  
12 community. Educating himself on multiple ethnic traditions and hardships has, in turn,  
13 given him the resources necessary to educate minorities and help them succeed in  
14 their financial endeavors. Romy's Lionism affiliations include: Charter 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice  
15 President of the Guam Sunshine Lions Club; Membership Director of the Guam Latte  
16 Stone Lions Club; Organizer and Charter President of the Guam Spirit Lions Club,  
17 2006-2007; Recipient of the President Excellence Award, 2007; Melvin Jones Fellow  
18 Recipient (Humanitarian Service Award), 2007-2008; Vice District Governor, 2009-  
19 2010; District Governor, 2010-2011; Founder's Membership Growth Award, 2010-  
20 2011; Certified Guiding Lion, 2013; and Global Membership Team Coordinator,  
21 2014-2015; and

22       **WHEREAS**, Lion Past District Governor Romy, which his Lion brothers and  
23 sisters call him, was installed as the District Governor for District 204 during the 93<sup>rd</sup>  
24 Lions Clubs International Convention held in Sydney, Australia; and included District

1   Governors from around the world. Twenty-one (21) Lion members attended and as the  
2   2010-2011 Lions Clubs International District Governor for District 204, he committed  
3   to serve and to be of service to others and to the community. Those programs and  
4   activities include: the annual Guam Liberation Day Parade in 2010; three (3) Health  
5   Fairs which were held at the *Hagåtña* Shopping Center, the *Dededo* Micronesia Mall  
6   and in Saipan; the “Touched By the Lions” Project of the Guam Spirit Lions Club  
7   wherein children with challenges from the Head Start Learning Center, Department of  
8   Education were afforded one day at the McDonalds *Tamuning* with the Lion members  
9   in which they were provided with school supplies, toys and their time; the “Feeding  
10   the Homeless” at the *Guma* San Jose Shelter, with a sumptuous Thanksgiving dinner  
11   and a time to converse with the adults and to play with the children were made  
12   available to the people in the shelter; visitations to Saipan, Rota and Tinian, as well as  
13   to the Marshall Islands were pursued for membership campaign drives, orientation,  
14   and induction of new members and fellowship; and the reactivation of the Saipan Fil-  
15   Am Lions Club was also accomplished; and

16       **WHEREAS**, Romy also was involved with the chartering of three (3) new Lions  
17   Clubs for District 204, namely, the Guam Rock Lions Club; the *Guåhan* Horizon  
18   Lions Club; and the Guam Isla Lions Club. Romy also sponsored the LEO Talent  
19   Program, which was participated in by the members of the LEO Clubs in the district.  
20   Through this endeavor, the LEOs were given the opportunities to showcase their  
21   talents in the field of performing arts, further enhanced their leadership skills, nurtured  
22   their camaraderie spirit, and developed their self confidence. Additionally, the LEO  
23   Youth Camp was also conducted under the sponsorship of the Guam Galaide Lions  
24   Club; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Romy is a proud recipient of the Lions Club’s President Excellence  
2 Award; the Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow, Founders’ Membership Growth Award  
3 for Lion Year 2010-2011 from the International President, Sid Scruggs III; the District  
4 Governor’s Extension Award for Lion Year 2010-2011 from the International  
5 President, Dr. Wing Kum-Tam in August 2012; and the District Governor’s  
6 Excellence Award from the International President, Sid Scruggs III, for his  
7 performance and accomplishments during Lion Year 2010-2011; and

8           **WHEREAS**, Romy was a part of the Global Membership Team taking charge of  
9 the success programs of the team, and was the chairperson of the International  
10 Relations Committee of District 204. Romy and his wife Fely reunite with their family  
11 in the United States during the month of July every summer which they look forward  
12 to every year. When they’re not with their immediate family, they always have their  
13 Lion brothers and sisters to celebrate their success and accomplishments with. Romy’s  
14 qualifications and achievements have made him a role model for individuals of  
15 Guam’s island community, who look to hard working business professionals such as  
16 Mr. Romeo A. Angel as reasons to stay on Guam and live their lives here in harmony  
17 and prosperity; now therefore, be it
