3 **WHEREAS,** Lieutenant Colonel Glenn Paulino is married to the former Eliza
4 Ann Unpingco; and their children are: Matthew Anthony, Stephen Joseph, Timothy
5 Paul and Erin Teresa; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Lieutenant Colonel Glenn Paulino enlisted in the U.S. Army
2 Reserve in 1983 as a Private, serving with the 411th Engineer Battalion on Guam; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in 1985, Lieutenant Colonel Glenn Paulino entered the University
4 of Guam Army Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) where he graduated and was
5 commissioned in 1988; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Lieutenant Colonel Glenn Paulino, then a newly commissioned
7 Second Lieutenant, attended the Armor Basic Officer Course and was subsequently
8 assigned to the 1st Cavalry Division at Fort Hood, Texas, as an Armor Platoon Leader
9 with Task Force 1-32nd Armor Regiment; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in 1990, then Lieutenant Glenn Paulino deployed with the First
11 Team in support of Operation Desert Shield and Desert Storm; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in 1993, following his completion of the Armor Advanced and the
13 Cavalry Leader's Courses and his promotion to the rank of Captain, Captain Paulino
14 was assigned to the Second Cavalry Regiment at Fort Polk, Louisiana, where he
15 deployed as a Troop Commander with the Second Squadron in support of the United
16 Nations Mission in Haiti; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Lieutenant Colonel Glenn Paulino's next assignment brought him
18 home to Guam where he served as a Captain with the University of Guam Army Reserve
19 Officer Training Corps (ROTC); and

20 **WHEREAS**, in 2003, Captain Glenn Paulino served as a Division Operations
21 Staff Officer in the 24th Infantry Division, Forward at Fort Jackson, South Carolina,
22 where he supported the mobilization of the Enhanced National Guard Brigades in
23 support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, and where he was promoted to the rank of Major;
24 and

25 **WHEREAS**, Major Glenn Paulino attended the Information Systems
26 Management Officer course in 2005 at Fort Gordon, Georgia; and subsequently, he was

1 assigned to the 25th Infantry Division at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii, as the Division
2 Automations Management Officer, during which time he was deployed to Iraq with the
3 Division from August 2006 to October 2007, and again from November 2008 to
4 October 2009; and

5 **WHEREAS**, following his completion of Intermediate Level Education (ILE) in
6 2010 and his promotion to his current rank of Lieutenant Colonel, Lieutenant Colonel
7 Glenn Paulino was assigned to the Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers, Europe in
8 Belgium where he served as a staff officer with the NATO Communications and
9 Information Agency until his final assignment to the Defense Information Systems
10 Agency Command Center in 2013; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Lieutenant Colonel Glenn Paulino's commitment, exemplary
12 service, leadership and courage has not gone unrecognized as evidenced by his rise in
13 rank and his numerous commendations and decorations, among which are the Defense
14 Meritorious Service Medal, the Bronze Star Medal, four (4) Meritorious Service
15 Medals, four (4) Army Commendation Medals, two (2) Army Achievement Medals, the
16 Meritorious Unit Citation, the National Defense Service Medal, the Southwest Asia
17 Service Medal, the Iraq Campaign Medal with 2 Bronze Service Stars, the Global War
18 on Terror Service Medal, the United Nations Mission in Haiti Medal, the Kuwait
19 Liberation Medal, and the Saudi Arabian Medal for the Liberation of Kuwait; and


20 **WHEREAS**, after more than thirty (30) years of honorable, exemplary and
21 courageous service to our nation, our island and our people, Lieutenant Colonel Glenn
22 Paulino will retire from the U.S. Army on June 28, 2016; now therefore, be it

23 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
24 *Lihselaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihselaturan Guåhan* and the people
25 of Guam, congratulate Lieutenant Colonel Glenn Paulino on the occasion of his

6 and children; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*.


