3 **WHEREAS**, Chief Warrant Officer Three Elizabeth Pereira Perez was born on
4 March 27, 1979; and she is the daughter of Joey and Gina Pereira from the village of
5 *Mangilao*. She has a brother, Joseph J. Pereira; a sister-in-law, Jackie; and a niece,
6 Dolce. Chief Warrant Officer Three Elizabeth Pereira Perez is married to her husband

1 of thirteen (13) years, Philip Perez. They have a sixteen (16) year old daughter named
2 Camille, and their family resides in Germany; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Chief Warrant Officer Three Elizabeth Pereira Perez is a 1997
4 graduate of the Academy of Our Lady of Guam. In 2001, she graduated from the
5 University of Guam (*cum laude*) where she earned her Bachelor of Social Work with a
6 minor in Sociology; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Chief Warrant Officer Three Elizabeth Pereira Perez enlisted in
8 the United States Army in 2002 as a Paralegal Specialist (MOS 27D); and she
9 progressed through the ranks to Staff Sergeant, and was selected to serve as a Warrant
10 Officer (Legal Administrator) in the Judge Advocate General's Corps in 2008; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Chief Warrant Officer Three Elizabeth Pereira Perez's military
12 education includes, the Paralegal Specialist Advanced Individual Training (Honor
13 Graduate), the Primary Leadership and Development Course (Commandant's List),
14 the Basic Noncommissioned Officer Course (Commandant's List), the Warrant
15 Officer Candidate Course (Distinguished Honor Graduate), the Judge Advocate
16 General's Warrant Officer Basic Course, and the Judge Advocate General's Warrant
17 Officer Advanced Course; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Chief Warrant Officer Three Elizabeth Pereira Perez served as a
19 Paralegal Specialist at Fort Lewis, Washington; Vicenza, Italy; Bagram, Afghanistan;
20 and Yongsan, South Korea. Since her appointment as a Warrant Officer in 2009, she
21 has served as the Legal Administrator for the U.S. Army Europe, Heidelberg,
22 Germany; U.S. Forces - Baghdad, Iraq; the 7th Infantry Division, Joint Base Lewis-
23 McChord, Washington; and the Seventh Army Joint Multinational Training
24 Command, Grafenwoehr, Germany. She was also selected to serve as the Executive
25 Officer, Juliet Company, 262nd Quartermaster Battalion - the 27D AIT Company, a
26 nominative position for JAG Corps Warrant Officers; and


27 **WHEREAS**, Chief Warrant Officer Three Elizabeth Pereira Perez is the Senior
28 Legal Administrator for the Office of the Staff Judge Advocate (OSJA), Seventh


1 Army Joint Multinational Training Command (7A JMTC), where she serves as the
2 Advisor to the Staff Judge Advocate on the management and operation of the OSJA.
3 Alongside the Senior Judge Advocate and the Senior Paralegal Noncommissioned
4 Officer in a General-Officer-level command, Chief Warrant Officer Three Perez leads,
5 mentors, and trains all assigned legal personnel in the corresponding general court-
6 martial footprint; and she supports the legal organization and all the legal personnel
7 who provide comprehensive legal services to the commanders, units, and other
8 organizations in the 7A JMTC area of operations; now therefore, be it
