10 acceptance into Pepperdine University, University of Hawaii in Manoa, University of

11 Portland and University of San Francisco; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Regine will be attending the U.S. Naval Academy on a full four

13 (4) year scholarship and run track for their team in Division One; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Regine's love for sports was sparked at the young age of five

15 (five) years old, and since then she has continually excelled in the sports of track and

16 field, volleyball, soccer and basketball. Regine's determination, self-motivation and

17 devotion as an athlete is what continues to inspire her coaches, her family, her friends

18 and the community; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Regine had always strived to be the finest athlete she could be

20 and committed many hours of training and sacrifice to succeed in every sport she

21 plays. She exhibited resilience and focus while competing for Guam in numerous

22 tournaments, and she plans to continue representing her island in the future; and

23 **WHEREAS**, from 2012 to 2015, Regine competed in the Oceania Track

24 Championships in Australia, Tahiti and the Cook Islands; and

25 **WHEREAS**, in 2013, Regine represented Guam in the Australian Junior Track

26 and Field Championships; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in 2014, she competed in the Brent International Track
2 Invitational Meet in the Philippines; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in 2015, she represented Guam in the IAAF World
4 Championships in Beijing, the IAAF World Youth Championships in Columbia, the
5 De La Salle Volleyball Invitational Tournament with the JFK Varsity Team in the
6 Philippines, and the National-Open Track and Field Philippines Championships; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in 2016, Regine competed in the Mike Petty Invitational Track
8 and Field Meet in Okinawa; and

9 **WHEREAS**, as a result of all her hard work and training, Regine has been
10 selected to represent Guam in the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio De Janeiro, Brazil; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Regine has also received numerous awards and recognitions
12 congratulating her for being a dedicated and committed student athlete; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Regine has achieved four (4) Guam National Track Women’s
14 Records, five (5) Guam High School Track Records, multiple gold medals from
15 IIAAG Track and Field All-Island, and a special Recognition of Excellence from the
16 GDOE Superintendent for being accepted into the U.S. Naval Academy; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Regine is also the female recipient of the 2016 “Shieh Su Ying
18 Scholar-Athlete of the Year Award”; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Regine continues to exhibit all the characteristics that a scholar-
20 athlete must have, especially with her compassion for the environment and the
21 community; and she has assisted with the *Alee* Shelter and the American Cancer
22 Society Relay for Life, as well as spending time helping with the elderly clients at St.
23 Dominic’s; and


24 **WHEREAS**, throughout her journey as a student-athlete, Regine was fortunate
