3        **WHEREAS, Sgt. Raymond C. Manibusan has dedicated more than thirty-five**  
4 **(35) years of service to the government of Guam while working at the Guam Police**

1 Department. He is the son of †Jose Laguana Manibusan and †Lourdes Camacho  
2 Manibusan. He will be celebrating his retirement with his seven (7) children: Melissa,  
3 Mark, Raymond Jr., Teliann, Ray, DemiRae, and Trista; his fourteen (14)  
4 grandchildren; and his partner of many years, Thelma; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in 1981, Raymond began his government of Guam career  
6 working as a Police Officer I; and with hard work, determination and dedication, he  
7 gained experience and continued to work his way up the ranks and was promoted to  
8 Police Officer II in December of 1989, Police Officer III in October of 1992, and in  
9 July of 1998, he was promoted to Police Sergeant; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Sgt. Ray Manibusan has shown his allegiance to the Guam Police  
11 Department - he has been awarded with numerous Letters of Commendation and  
12 Appreciation through the years, and has been recognized for his professionalism,  
13 exemplary performance and outstanding dedication to the force. In May of 1984, he  
14 was awarded with the Department of Public Safety (DPS) Lifesaving Award, and two  
15 (2) Silver Stars. In February 1989, he was awarded with the Meritorious Service  
16 Medal for Lifesaving and Valor. In May 2002, he was awarded with the Distinguished  
17 Service Medal; and in 2004, he was awarded with the Service Medal; and

18 **WHEREAS**, throughout his career, Sgt. Manibusan has garnered the respect  
19 from his colleagues and peers for going above and beyond the call of duty during his  
20 years of service at the Guam Police Department. He has been a positive role model  
21 amongst his colleagues, and he has always encouraged them to perform their duties in  
22 an efficient manner; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Sgt. Manibusan initiated the “Meet the Kids” Program in 2001, a  
24 collaboration between the Guam Police Department (GPD) and students from various  
25 public schools on the island. It is an ongoing program that allows GPD to interact  
26 with students teaching them lessons on various topics such as “Bullying” and “Saying

1 No to Drugs.” In 2013, he was also involved with spearheading presentations at  
2 various public schools on subjects such as traffic and pedestrian safety; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Sgt. Ray Manibusan established the Neighborhood Watch  
4 Program in *Dededo* and *Yigo* in 2014, and also established the Program in *Tamuning*  
5 in 2015. He assists the village mayors with implementing this Neighborhood Watch  
6 Program, and he will continue to pursue it going forward. He is also an active  
7 member of the Board of Directors of the Guam Senior Bowling Federation. He says  
8 he plans to enjoy his retirement; now therefore, be it
