- WHEREAS, the Guam Association of Realtors® (GAR), formerly known as

membership meeting at Fjord's Smorgette with close to thirty-two (32) aspiring
 members in attendance; and
 WHEREAS, in November 1971, the Guam Association of Realtors® became a

part of what would become today one of the largest and influential trade industries in

the nation, the National Association of REALTORS® (NAR), then known as the

National Association of Real Estate Boards; and

WHEREAS, to the present date, the Guam Association of REALTORS® has grown with close to four hundred (400) members strong; and is the constant "Voice for Real Estate" on Guam. The GAR is proud to be part of the one (1) million-member strong NAR organization; and

WHEREAS, the term REALTOR® is a registered collective membership trademark that identifies a real estate professional who is a member of the National Association of REALTORS® and subscribes to its strict code of ethics; and

WHEREAS, all real estate licensees are not the same; and only real estate licensees who are members of the NAR are properly called REALTORS®; they proudly display the REALTOR® logo on their business cards, or other marketing and sales literature; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® are committed to treating all parties to a real estate transaction honestly; and they subscribe to a strict code of ethics and are expected to maintain a higher level of knowledge of the process of buying and selling real estate. An independent survey reports that eighty-four percent (84%) of home buyers would use the same REALTOR® again; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® are very capable in determining a person's buying power and referring them to lenders that are best qualified to help them; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® have many resources to assist them in searching for homes, especially those not actively advertised in the market; and they will thoroughly investigate to find all available properties; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® assist in the selection process by providing objective information about each property, and they can provide the local community with information on utilities, zoning, schools, etc.; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® help their clients to negotiate, including, but not limited to, price, financing, terms, date of possession, and often, the inclusion or exclusion of repairs and furnishings or equipment; and they can also advise their clients as to which investigations and inspections are recommended or required; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® provide due diligence during the evaluation of the property, and depending on the area and property, it could include inspections for termites, dry rot, asbestos, faulty structure, roof condition, septic tank and well tests, to name a few; and they can also assist with finding qualified responsible professionals to do most of the investigations and provide written reports. Along with the title company or attorney, the REALTOR® can help resolve issues that might cause problems at a later date; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® can help their clients better understand different financing options and identify qualified lenders; and they can also guide them through the closing process to make sure everything flows together smoothly; and

WHEREAS, when it comes to selling a home, REALTORS® can provide upto-date information on what is happening in the marketplace, and the price, financing, terms and condition of competing properties; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® will often recommend repairs or cosmetic work that will significantly enhance the salability of a client's property; and markets the property to other real estate agents and the public; and they act as the marketing

1 coordinator, disbursing information about the property to other real estate agents

2 through a Multiple Listing Service or other cooperative marketing networks, open

houses for agents, etc. The REALTOR® Code of Ethics requires REALTORS® to

utilize these cooperative relationships when they benefit their clients; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® know when, where and how to advertise a property and can help a client objectively evaluate every buyer's proposal without compromising their marketing position. They can also help a client write a legally binding, win-win agreement that will be more likely to make it through the process; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® can assist with the closing of the sale of a home, and are the best persons to objectively help resolve issues and move the transaction to closing or settlement; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Association of REALTORS® is always committed to promoting professionalism in the real estate business; and due to such commitment, has put forth a week-long educational opportunity for the REALTORS®. The Association believes in continuing education and in increasing the knowledge of its members about the business, which ultimately benefits the end consumers; now therefore, be it
