- 3 Baza Reyes, also of Ordot, Guam; and
- WHEREAS, Ben and Susie Arceo were classmates in the 4th Grade at *Chalan*
- 5 Pago Elementary School; and they later became sweethearts after their Junior Prom at
- 6 George Washington High School; and
- WHEREAS, Ben Arceo served honorably in the United States Army during the
- 8 Korean War, but before going off to serve, he would not leave unless he and Susie
- 9 were married; and therefore, Ben and Susie were united in the Holy Bonds of
- 10 Matrimony on September 16, 1950, at the San Juan Bautista Catholic Church in
