WHEREAS, Eduardo Dela Pena began his educational journey with the Guam
Community College (GCC) as a high school student; and he eventually graduated
with the Class of 1981, with a concentration in Computer Science; and
WHEREAS, Eduardo was a member of the Nutrie of the Science in the science.

6 WHEREAS, Eduardo was a member of the National Honor Society, and he 7 was involved in many extra-curricular sports. He also received the "Top of the Shop" award during his senior year. After graduating from high school, Eduardo joined the
 workforce on Guam, while pursuing a post-secondary education at both GCC and the
 University of Guam (UOG) under a merit scholarship; and

WHEREAS, in 1984, Eduardo was nominated to the U.S. Air Force Academy
in Colorado Springs, Colorado, and the U.S. Military Academy in West Point, New
York. After careful consideration, he decided to attend the Air Force Academy where
he received a Bachelor of Science degree in general studies. In 1988, he was
commissioned into the U.S. Air Force as a Second Lieutenant; and

9 WHEREAS, Eduardo's active duty military career expanded over the course of 10 twenty (20) years; and he had succeeded with many requirements in order to advance 11 in his career. During the year of his Command Staff College, he also pursued a degree 12 at Webster University in Colorado, where he graduated with a Master's degree in 13 Human Resources Development, one of his life's passions; and

WHEREAS, one of Eduardo's greatest personal accomplishments during his military career was returning to the Air Force Academy to serve as Deputy of the Human Relations Character Development Division. While serving there, his passion for helping people grew as he helped to train the cadets in character development; and

WHEREAS, Eduardo has always had a big heart in wanting to help others in any way possible. After retiring from the military and working for Naval Facilities Guam, he still found the time to volunteer with the American Red Cross, Guam Chapter, as one of their liaisons and as a member of the Disaster Action Team; and

WHEREAS, in 2005, Eduardo launched the first Sexual Assault Response Coordinator's (SARC) office at Anderson AFB, Guam. This office was established to coordinate sexual assault victim care. In 2008, after returning from Saudi Arabia, he retired from Active Duty at the rank of Major; and WHEREAS, Eduardo loved the island life, and he decided to live on Guam where he has continued to help our community in any way possible. He now works at Naval Facilities Guam as a Program Analyst in the Business Development Division; and he continues to volunteer with the American Red Cross, and with various other agencies; and

6 WHEREAS, in 2011, Eduardo felt the urge to continue in his passion for the 7 field of human resources, and he decided to take classes at GCC for his Professional in 8 Human Resources (PHR) Certificate. In 2012, he received his PHR Certificate by the 9 HR Certificate Institution. He has returned to GCC for refresher courses in which he 10 continues to use his knowledge and skills to better his performance in the workplace; 11 and

12 WHEREAS, aside from all of Eduardo's military and educational 13 achievements, one of his personal and greatest feats and joy is raising his ten (10) 14 nieces and nephews. He and his wife, Dolores, have taken in the children, with some 15 that have been with them since infancy. Three (3) of them are foster children and 16 siblings of the children they're raising. Some of them are still in grade school, or 17 going to college; and one is in the workforce now. Eduardo and his wife, Dolores, 18 have genuinely opened their home and their hearts to these children, and the children 19 fully respect and appreciate them for raising and teaching them strong values; now therefore, be it 20
