3 **WHEREAS,** Captain Joey A. Terlaje, Guam Marshal Supervisor, was born on
4 March 31, 1973; and he is the son of Mayor Jose “Pedo” Terlaje and Mrs. Flo Terlaje
5 from the village of *Yona*; and his siblings are Joel, Joshua and Janet; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje celebrates his service and accomplishments
2 with Melissa, his wife of nineteen (19) years; and his children: Joey Jr., Joneen,
3 Jonessa, Jonavon, Jodeci and Jon Luke; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje is a Criminal Justice Major with more than
5 twenty-four (24) years of experience in law enforcement, and he currently serves as a
6 Supervisor/Captain with the Judiciary of Guam Marshals Division. He is a
7 professionally active and well-rounded individual who is involved with numerous
8 tactical trainings, to include: Active Shooter Instructor (Andersen Air Force Base,
9 Guam); Laser Shot Firearms Simulator (*Mangilao*, Guam); Blackwater Special
10 Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) Instructor (Moyock, North Carolina); Defensive
11 Tactics Instructor (PPCT); Impact Weapon or MEB (PPCT); Tactical Handcuffing
12 (PPCT); Inmate Escort (PPCT); Pepper Spray (OCAT); Incident Response to a
13 Terrorist Bombing (Socorro, New Mexico); Prevention Response to a Suicide
14 Bombing Incident (Deming, New Mexico); Introduction to Weapons of Mass
15 Destruction (Las Vegas, Nevada); Tactical Tracker (Mesquite, Nevada); Firearms
16 Instructor (Sig Sauer Academy); Folding Knife Instructor (*Hagåtña*, Guam); Low
17 Light Principles for Law Enforcement Instructor (PPCT); and Spontaneous Knife
18 Defense Instructor (PPCT); and

19 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje has received advance trainings, to include:
20 the United States Marine Corps Combat Handgun Course; the Drug Enforcement
21 Administration (DEA) Close Quarters Battle; the Federal Bureau of Investigations
22 (FBI) Police Officers Survival School; Guam Homeland Security trainings; the U.S.
23 Customs Officers Survival Course; U.S. Marshals Service trainings; the Navy SEALs
24 Close-Quarter-Battle (CQB); the National Tactical Officers Association (NTOA)
25 SWAT Commanders Course in Las Vegas, Nevada; and most recently, he was

1 nominated for the United States Secret Service Dignitary Protection Training Session
2 204-16 in Washington, D.C., which Captain Terlaje completed in June 2016; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje’s completion of these intensive programs
4 provides an opportunity for the hard-working and dedicated men and women to
5 reinforce the love of their job and apply the tools learned through the programs,
6 providing for an added layer of knowledge and support in caring for the people of
7 Guam; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje is a former Guam Airport Police Officer,
9 and he is a graduate of the Guam Police Academy, Guam Police Department First (1st)
10 SWAT Cycle, in 1994; and in 2000, he attended the Blackwater SWAT Instructor
11 Academy at the main facility in Moyock, North Carolina, all of which are not easily
12 attained; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje received the Justice F. Philip Carbullido
14 Coin for his outstanding service; and he has received numerous awards and
15 recognition from the Guam Community College, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*, *I*
16 *Liheslaturan Guåhan*, the Guam Police Department (GPD), and the Department of
17 Education (DOE); and

18 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje is the founder of the Special Enforcement
19 and Tactics Team (SET) for the Guam Marshals Division; and he is highly recognized
20 as a Master Tactician by his peers, and holds a brown belt in the Universal Kempo
21 Karate Schools Association; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje was awarded as the 2014 Employee
23 Recognition Program (ERP) “Supervisor of the Year”; he is a 2009 Medal of Valor
24 winner; and he was nominated for the 2009 “Employee of the Year” award, and was
25 awarded second (2nd) place by the Justice Committee; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje is currently the Officer-in-Charge for the
2 Training Section of the Judiciary of Guam Marshals Division, where he has served
3 since 2007; and since 2005, he has been teaching quality, informative, realistic, recent
4 and relevant law enforcement courses in Guam, the Commonwealth of the Northern
5 Mariana Islands and the Micronesian region, to include, Palau, Chuuk, Yap, Pohnpei,
6 Kosrae and Majuro; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje was the Senior Cadre/Adjunct Instructor for
8 the Tenth (10th), Eleventh (11th), Twelfth (12th) and Thirteenth (13th), and is now
9 concluding the Fourteenth (14th) Criminal Justice Supplemental Academy at the Guam
10 Community College as Senior Cadre, which started on May 6, 2016, and will
11 conclude on August 13, 2016. He has been an instructor for hundreds of students in
12 the private sector, as well as law enforcement officers, SWAT teams, Guam Marshals,
13 the 1st Guam Volunteer Deputy Marshal Reserve Program, Guam Police Officers,
14 Parole and Probation Officers, Corrections Officers, Airport Police Officers, Customs
15 Officers, Department of Youth Affairs Officers, Special Deputy Marshals/Truant
16 Officers, and Security Officers; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje is highly motivated, competent, and confident
18 in his instructional methodologies that instill the virtues of organization, meticulous
19 attention to detail, positive and assertive decision-making, and ethical conduct on his
20 cadets to create a safe training environment; now therefore, be it
