1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN***  
2 ***GUÁHAN*:**

3           **WHEREAS**, Chief Michael Aguon has dedicated thirty-six (36) years of  
4 service to the government of Guam, working at the Guam Fire Department. He is the  
5 son of †Jesus Fejeran Aguon and Adelina Meno Dueñas. He will be celebrating his

1 retirement with his wife of twenty-nine (29) years, Mrs. Dolores Aguon; their two (2)  
2 children, Gabrielle and Michael; and their two (2) wonderful grandchildren, Adam  
3 and Ayden; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Chief Aguon was born and raised in the *beautiful* village of  
5 *Malojloj*, and now resides in the *beautiful* village of *Chalan Pago*. In his own words,  
6 “He lives in *Malojloj* but sleeps in *Chalan Pago*;” and

7 **WHEREAS**, Michael had attended Catholic and public schools, and he is truly  
8 proud to be a 1979 graduate of Father Dueñas Memorial School – an institution and  
9 brotherhood strong in faith and steeped in tradition; and

10 **WHEREAS**, upon the encouragement and advice of his parents, Chief Aguon  
11 enrolled in the Fire Service with the Guam Fire Department on August 8, 1983, with  
12 the 6<sup>th</sup> Fire Academy Cycle. He graduated on March 10, 1984, earning academic  
13 honors as the top EMT of the class, as well as other recognitions; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Michael was promoted to Firefighter II and with hard work and  
15 dedication he worked his way up the ranks and became a Fire Captain in 1991, serving  
16 as the Rescue & Station Officer in Charge (OIC) and Emergency Medical Services  
17 (EMS) Operations Supervisor. He was also assigned to serve as an Acting District  
18 Commander above more senior officers in the Department. In 1997, Chief Aguon was  
19 promoted to Battalion Fire Chief, a position he has held for the past nineteen (19)  
20 years; and

21 **WHEREAS**, Chief Michael Aguon was part of the original Search and Rescue  
22 Unit that the Guam Fire Department established in 1985, and he is also one of the first  
23 officers to be certified as a Haz-Mat Tech. During his tenure as Battalion Fire Chief,  
24 he was the Operations Commander for Fire Prevention, Fire Suppression, Rescue and  
25 EMS. His last assignment with the Department was as the Bureau Chief for Fire  
26 Suppression & EMS Rescue. Chief Michael E.D. Aguon was instrumental in

1 providing mentorship and leadership to those that were fortunate to serve under his  
2 command; and

3 **WHEREAS**, throughout his career, Chief Michael E.D. Aguon has provided  
4 exceptional meritorious service to the people of Guam while working with the Guam  
5 Fire Department; now therefore, be it

6 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,  
7 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and extend *Un Dângkolo Na Si Yu'os*  
8 *Ma'åse'* to Fire Battalion Chief Michael E.D. Aguon on his retirement after more than  
9 thirty-six (36) years of government of Guam service with the Guam Fire Department;  
10 and does further extend best wishes to him in his future endeavors; and be it further


11 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to,
