1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

1 **WHEREAS**, on August 5, 1956, history was made on Guam as KUAM TV
2 signed on the air and broadcasted for the first time; and

3 **WHEREAS**, a group of California executives, led by broadcasting entrepreneur
4 Harry Engel, were responsible for bringing the first local community television station
5 to the island as an NBC affiliate; and

6 **WHEREAS**, today, KUAM TV is proud to be locally owned and operated as
7 part of the Pacific Telestations LLC Media Group. KUAM TV has maintained its
8 position as an innovator of local broadcasting through the years as generations of
9 Guamanians have relied on this local broadcast leader for local and national news,
10 information and entertainment; and

11 **WHEREAS**, KUAM TV’s commitment to our local community throughout its
12 history is evidenced by the litany of informative, entertaining, cultural and unique
13 local programs it has produced through the years, to include, among others, “The
14 Rosary Hour”; “The Allen Sekt Talent Show”; “Women’s World with Madeleine
15 Bordallo”; Guam’s first live televised nightly newscast; countless fund-raising
16 telethons for local charities and in the wake of natural disasters; holiday specials;
17 talent competitions such as “Island Stars”; sports telecasts; political debates; live
18 election coverage; broadcasts of special events, news and lifestyle programs such as
19 “Island Focus”; reality game shows like the “The Guamazing Race”; and much more;
20 and

21 **WHEREAS**, the KUAM TV news team has been on the scene during landmark
22 events and in times of tragedy and disaster to keep our local community connected,
23 and to serve a global community through providing information to international news
24 networks and via digital media platforms in more recent years; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Special KUAM TV News Team coverage has included the State
2 of the Island Addresses and inaugurations, typhoon and disaster coverage, the historic
3 visit of Pope John Paul II, the crash of Korean Airlines Flight 801, the historic visit of
4 President Bill Clinton, the Seventh Day Adventist mass shooting, the tragedy in
5 *Tumon*, and coverage of the annual Liberation Day Parade; and

6 **WHEREAS**, through its community service initiative, the KUAM Care Force
7 has instituted community wide service activities; it launched the recognition awards
8 program, “KUAM Care Force Honors”; and it has provided hundreds of hours of
9 airtime to broadcast public service announcements; and

10 **WHEREAS**, on its Sixtieth (60th) Year Anniversary, KUAM TV celebrates all
11 of the media broadcasting milestones it has been able to bring into households on
12 Guam and the global community; and

13 **WHEREAS**, this commemorative anniversary is not only a time to look back
14 on where KUAM TV has been, but a time to look forward to see it carrying out its
15 mission of being “*First on Guam*” into a new era with more ways to connect our
16 community now more than ever; now therefore, be it

17 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
18 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
19 of Guam, recognize, commend and congratulate KUAM TV on the momentous
20 occasion of its Sixtieth (60th) Year Anniversary, and extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os*
21 *Ma'åse'* to KUAM TV for being an excellent medium for the broadcasting of local and
22 national news, information and entertainment to our island community, and for its

4 Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*.


