7	had received numerous commendations for her various outstanding accomplishments

9	WHEREAS, after her years of commitment and perseverance, Sgt. Martin was
10	promoted to the position of Corrections Officer III on December 13, 1981; and
11	WHEREAS, Maria was a well-respected Officer and an articulate Platoon
