1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Maria Rosita Crisostomo Martin, better known as “Rosie”
4 or “Sgt. Martin,” was born on August 28, 1956, and is from the village of *Dededo*; and

1 **WHEREAS**, on February 23, 1976, at the young age of twenty (20), Maria began
2 her government of Guam career working at the Department of Corrections (DOC), and
3 is the first (1st) female Corrections Officer on Guam; and

4 **WHEREAS**, with her hard work and dedication, Maria was promoted to the
5 position of Corrections Officer II on October 8, 1978; and

6 **WHEREAS**, throughout her career with the Department of Corrections, Maria
7 had received numerous commendations for her various outstanding accomplishments
8 and contributions to the agency; and

9 **WHEREAS**, after her years of commitment and perseverance, Sgt. Martin was
10 promoted to the position of Corrections Officer III on December 13, 1981; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Maria was a well-respected Officer and an articulate Platoon
12 Commander with an outgoing and well-rounded personality; and she was
13 knowledgeable of her assignments and excelled at all she was tasked to do; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Maria was well known for contributing her time and efforts at
15 assuring that the Department's events and functions were a true success; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Maria is the first female Corrections Officer; and was hired to serve
17 at the former Guam Penitentiary before it transitioned into the Department of
18 Corrections. She was a mentor to all her subsequent officers and was always willing to
19 teach new employees her skills; and

20 **WHEREAS**, on March 31, 1987, after many years of service under her belt,
21 Maria was recognized for her allegiance to the agency and was promoted to the position
22 of Sergeant I until she retired as an honorary Lieutenant II on September 30, 2011; and

23 **WHEREAS**, always with the mission of the Department in mind, Maria created
24 the Department of Corrections Employees Association to help DOC employees during
25 hardships and for DOC celebrations; she was a member of the Disciplinary Hearing

1 Board, the Adjustment Classification Committee, and the Appeals Committee; and she
2 worked on policies and protocol, and was the Computation and Release Officer; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Maria Rosita Crisostomo Martin will be dearly missed by
4 her family, friends, and especially her former peers and co-workers at the Department
5 of Corrections; now therefore, be it


6 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
