2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Senior Probation Officer Leo S. Diaz has over twenty-three (23)
4 years of law enforcement experience. In September of 1993, he was hired at the
5 Judiciary of Guam and served as a Deputy Marshal. He later attended the Guam

1 Police Department's Thirty-sixth (36th) Academy in 1995; and he has continued to
2 work for the Guam Police Department Reserve until the present time; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in 1996, Senior Probation Officer Leo S. Diaz transferred to the
4 Judiciary of Guam's Probation Office, where he has continued to progress in the
5 capacity of his current position as a Senior Probation Officer; and

6 **WHEREAS**, in 1998, Senior Probation Officer Leo S. Diaz attended the Guam
7 Police Department's 2nd Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) cycle; and has
8 remained an active member of the team; and

9 **WHEREAS**, in September 2000, Senior Probation Officer Leo S. Diaz
10 graduated from the United States Basic Air Force Academy; and has continued to
11 serve his country with over sixteen (16) years of experience under his belt; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Leo is a Certified Instructor in the following: Active
13 Shooter/High Risk Response (ANSER), and TASER instructor (GPD); and he is
14 currently assigned to the Marshal's Training Section as an instructor assisting with
15 various specialty instruction, such as: Active Shooter, Basic and Advanced Close
16 Quarters Battle, and Spontaneous Knife Defense. In addition, he recently returned
17 from training the Yapese Police Department and other law enforcement entities; and

18 **WHEREAS**, after graduating from high school in 1985, Leo received his
19 Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice in 1992; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Senior Probation Officer Leo S. Diaz had received numerous
21 commendations and awards throughout his law enforcement career, including two (2)
22 Legislative Certificates recognizing him for providing his service with two (2)
23 Criminal Justice Academies; and


24 **WHEREAS**, it takes a courageous person to be a law enforcement officer and

2 enforcement officers for what they do every day; now therefore, be it


3 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
