3 **WHEREAS**, Deputy Camacho has been assigned to the Judiciary of Guam's
4 Training and Staff Development Section, augmenting operations as a Certified
5 Instructor, since August 10, 2015; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in 1998, Deputy Camacho started his law enforcement career with
2 the Guam Police Department, where he served as a Civilian Volunteer Police
3 Reservist with the 12th CVPR Cycle after completing the 6th Basic Law Enforcement
4 Academy; and shortly after that, he transitioned to becoming a full time police officer
5 with the 41st Guam Police Cycle in 1999; and he served as a police officer for sixteen
6 (16) years; and

7 **WHEREAS**, throughout his career as a police officer, Deputy Camacho
8 received a comprehensive background in training, along with the experiences when he
9 was assigned to the Special Operations Division as a full time SWAT member earning
10 a multitude of certifications, such as: Sniper Certification; Active Shooter; Rappel
11 Master; Advance Sniper and Sniper Instructor; Armorer's Certification; Firearms
12 Instructor; Glock Firearms Instructor; Advance SWAT Type III Training; FLETC
13 U.S. Coast Guard Boarding Team School; and the Violent Fugitive Taskforce; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Deputy Camacho is also an enlisted military member with the
15 United States Coast Guard Reserve, where he serves as an E5 Second Class Petty
16 Officer with the responsibilities as a maritime law enforcement officer for the port and
17 coastal waterways of Guam; and

18 **WHEREAS**, it takes a courageous person to be a law enforcement officer and
19 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* commends these people for putting their health, safety, and lives
20 on the line every day to maintain public safety within our island community; and
21 hopes to continue to keep our law enforcement officers at the forefront of all
22 applicable P.O.S.T. requirements. They have a tremendous responsibility and are
23 owed our island's gratitude. *Un Dângkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* goes out to all law
24 enforcement officers for what they do every day; now therefore, be it

26 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people


