1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Deputy Marshal Sergeant Josef Sablan has a comprehensive law
4 enforcement background with more than twenty (20) years of service as a full time
5 Deputy Marshal with the Judiciary of Guam; and

6 **WHEREAS,** Deputy Sablan has held a considerable amount of jobs
7 concurrently and has worked as a Police Reserve for about seventeen (17) years, as

1 well as a Federal Screening Officer for the last thirteen (13) years. He was recently
2 hired as an Adjunct Faculty at the Guam Community College as an Emergency
3 Vehicle Operator's Course (EVOC) Instructor; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Deputy Sablan is a graduate of the Guam Police Department's
5 39th Cycle Academy; the Judiciary of Guam's Special Enforcement Tactics training;
6 the Guam Police Department's 14th Reserve Cycle; and the Tidewater Community
7 College, where he received an Associate's Degree in Administration of Justice. In
8 addition, he served as a Special Agent at the Guam Police Department's Criminal
9 Investigations Section, and was assigned to the Unsolved Homicide Taskforce; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Deputy Sablan is a Certified Instructor in the following: Active
11 Shooter/High Risk Response; Law Enforcement Response to WMD Incidents; and
12 Emergency Vehicle Operator Course; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Deputy Sablan is currently assigned to serve at the Marshal's
14 Training Section, and also holds a collateral duty as the Judiciary's canine explosive
15 handler. Deputy Sablan has cross trained with the U.S. Marshals Service in Protective
16 Services and Defensive Tactics, the Guam Police Department's K9 Division, the
17 Transportation Security Administration's K9 Division, the Guam International Airport
18 Authority Police's K9 Division, and the U.S. Navy's K9 Division; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Deputy Sablan is trained and certified to conduct training in the
20 Emergency Vehicle Operator's Course (EVOC), and he recently provided EVOC
21 instructional training at the Guam Community College for the 13th Criminal Justice
22 Cycle. He continues to assist instructing in the response for Active Shooter training
23 throughout the island of Guam in the public education system; and

24 **WHEREAS**, it takes a courageous person to be a law enforcement officer and
25 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* commends these people for putting their health, safety, and lives
26 on the line every day to maintain public safety within our island community; and
27 hopes to continue to keep our law enforcement officers at the forefront of all

1 applicable P.O.S.T. requirements. They have a tremendous responsibility and are
2 owed our island's gratitude. *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ãse'* goes out to all law
3 enforcement officers for what they do every day; now therefore, be it

4 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
5 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
6 of Guam, recognize and commend Deputy Marshal Sergeant Josef Sablan for his
7 support and exceptional achievements in conducting professional standards while
8 instructing the law enforcement participants of the Judiciary of Guam's Criminal
9 Justice Academy; and does further extend *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ãse'* to him
10 for his commitment to improving the safety and protection of the island community;



