8 Republic of Palau, and the Republic of the Marshall Islands, the Lions Clubs of Guam are

1 a part of District 204 of Lions Clubs International, which is the world's largest service
2 club organization with forty-six thousand (46,000) clubs and over one million four
3 hundred thousand (1,400,000) members in over two hundred (200) countries and
4 geographical areas; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Lions Clubs are well-known for its leadership and initiative in
6 identifying community needs, and then developing strategies to meet those needs; and

7 **WHEREAS**, as is true with other organizations of leaders, there emerge members
8 who answer the call of their membership to become a leader among them; and

9 **WHEREAS**, such is the case with Ms. Lynda Tolan who, on September 10, 2016,
10 will be inaugurated as Centennial District Governor of Lions Clubs International District

16 President of Guam Paradise Lions Club; Charter President and four (4)-time President of
17 Guam Harmony Lions Club; Zone Chair; Region Chair; Second Vice District Governor;
18 and First Vice District Governor; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Lynda Tolan has worked to expand the opportunities for others
20 to serve our community through the chartering of the Guam *Galaide* Lions Club, the
21 Guam Harmony Lions Club, the Guam *Ifit* Lions Club, the Guam Serenity Lions Club,
22 the Guam Paradise Leo Club, the Guam Harmony Leo Club I, and the Guam Harmony
23 Leo Club II; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Lynda Tolan's hard work, dedication, and commitment to the
25 Lions Clubs' causes has not gone unrecognized or unrewarded on the club level, the
26 district level and the international level; and

27 **WHEREAS**, among the many awards given to Ms. Lynda Tolan are the "Lion of
28 the Year" Award, the President's Award, the District 204 Service Award, the District 204

1 Appreciation Award, the Lions Clubs International Progressive Melvin Jones Award, the
2 Lions Clubs International Club Excellence Award, the Lions Clubs International
3 Leadership Award, and the Lions Clubs International Certificate of Leadership; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Lynda Tolan's impressive record of community service extends
5 beyond her work with the Lions Clubs as she continues to be active in such organizations
6 as the Filipino Ladies Association of Guam, the Filipino American Presidents Club of
7 Guam, the *Nino Perdido Y Sagrada* Parish Finance Council, and the *Nino Perdido Y*
8 *Sagrada* Parish Choir; now therefore, be it


9 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
