Pika's Café showcases locally inspired breakfast and lunch dishes in a variety of cuisine that is cooked with locally grown fresh produce. Their success is validated through several awards they have received that were voted on by the island community. They've been awarded as "Best Breakfast" and "Best Deli & Sandwich" in 2015 by the Pacific Daily News "Pika Best of Guam." Pika's Café has been a member in good standing of the Guam Chamber of Commerce since February 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Fejerans' strong commitment to the local culture and providing continuous support for local small businesses can be seen in numerous ways. One of their most popular drinks is made from locally-grown calamansi and mint, which they get from locally-owned farms on a daily basis; and

WHEREAS, the Fejerans have partnered with other small businesses for cross promotions to enhance exposure for other businesses, and they have shown their true island spirit and hospitality. Another successful event is the "Pop-Up" Chefs to promote other local and off-island talents, such as Prubechu Restaurant of San Francisco, California, and the Underground Supper Club with Mid-Pac.
