- WHEREAS, the Guam Association of Realtors® (GAR), formerly known as
- 4 the "Guam Real Estate Board," was founded in 1970; and held its first general

1 membership meeting at Fjord's Smorgette with close to thirty-two (32) aspiring

2 members in attendance; and

WHEREAS, in November 1971, the Guam Association of Realtors® became a part of what would become one of the largest and most influential trade industries in the nation today, the National Association of Realtors® (NAR), which was then known as the "National Association of Real Estate Boards"; and

WHEREAS, to this date, the Guam Association of Realtors® has grown with close to four hundred (400) members strong; and is the constant "Voice for Real Estate" on Guam. GAR is proud to be part of the one (1) million member strong of NAR; and

WHEREAS, the term Realtor® is a registered collective membership mark that identifies a real estate professional who is a member of the National Association of Realtors®, and subscribes to its strict Code of Ethics; and

WHEREAS, all real estate licensees are not the same, and only real estate licensees who are members of the NAR are properly called Realtors®; and they proudly display the Realtor® logo on their business cards or other marketing and sales literature; and

WHEREAS, Realtors® are committed to treat all parties to a transaction honestly; and they subscribe to a strict code of ethics, and are expected to maintain a higher level of knowledge of the process of buying and selling real estate. An independent survey reports that eighty-four percent (84%) of homebuyers would use the same Realtor® again; and

WHEREAS, Realtors® are very capable in determining a person's buying power and referring them to lenders that are best qualified to help them; and

WHEREAS, Realtors® have many resources to assist them in searching for homes, especially those not actively advertised in the market, and will thoroughly investigate to find all available properties; and

WHEREAS, Realtors® assist in the selection process by providing objective information about each property; and they can provide the local community with information on utilities, zoning, schools, etc.; and

WHEREAS, Realtors® help their clients to negotiate, including, but not limited to, price, financing, terms, date of possession, and often, the inclusion or exclusion of repairs and furnishings or equipment; and they can also advise clients as to which investigations and inspections are recommended or required; and

WHEREAS, Realtors® provide due diligence during the evaluation of the property and, depending on the area and property, such evaluation could include inspections for termites, dry rot, asbestos, faulty structure, roof condition, septic tank and well tests, just to name a few; and they can also assist with finding qualified responsible professionals to do most of the investigations and provide written reports. Along with the title company or attorney, the Realtor® can help resolve issues that might cause problems at a later date; and

WHEREAS, Realtors® help their clients better understand the different financing options, assist in identifying qualified lenders, and also guide clients through the closing process to make sure everything flows together smoothly; and

WHEREAS, when it comes to selling a home, Realtors® can provide up-todate information on what is happening in the marketplace, and the price, financing, terms and condition of competing properties; and

WHEREAS, Realtors® will often recommend repairs or cosmetic work that will significantly enhance the salability of a client's property; they market the property to other real estate agents and the public; and they act as the marketing coordinator, disbursing information about the property to other real estate agents through a multiple listing service or other cooperative marketing networks, open houses for agents, etc. The Realtor® Code of Ethics requires Realtors® to utilize these cooperative relationships when it benefits their clients; and

WHEREAS, Realtors® know when, where and how to advertise a property and can help a client objectively evaluate every buyer's proposal without compromising their marketing position. They can also help a client write a legally binding, win-win agreement that will be more likely to make it through the process; and

WHEREAS, Realtors® can assist with closing the sale of a home, and are the best persons to objectively help resolve issues and move the transaction to closing or settlement; and

WHEREAS, the National Association of Realtors heavily promotes safety all year through its various programs; and the month of September 2016 is dedicated to educating the Realtors® about safety at home, at the office, at property showings, and at open houses; and even educate about internet security; and the National Association of Realtors recommends that safety courses be granted continuing education credits as it is an integral part of the business; and

WHEREAS, the focus is to help Realtors® be educated about the core components of safety through knowledge, awareness and empowerment. Reminding them of the unique risks they face every day in business, taking precautionary measures to protect themselves from danger, understanding whether to fight or escape when faced with menacing behavior, protecting themselves from cybercrime, and even surviving harsh weather conditions, can mean saving a life, their own or their clients; and
