1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Cristina E. Carlos Cubol was born on January 31, 1960, in
4 the city of Malolos in the Bulacan Province of the Republic of the Philippines. On
5 September 21, 1971, Mrs. Cubol migrated to Guam to join her father, Cresencio R.
6 Carlos; and later, she married Leonardo M. Cubol; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Cubol attended Santa Barbara Catholic School, completed
2 her middle school studies at *Dededo* Middle School, and graduated from the Academy
3 of Our Lady of Guam in 1979; and

4 **WHEREAS**, with the desire to make a positive impact in the lives of children,
5 Mrs. Cubol earned a Bachelor’s Degree in Elementary Education from the University
6 of Guam in 1985, and a Master’s Degree in Education in 1996; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in 1985, Mrs. Cubol began her career as a Guam educator with
8 the Andersen Elementary School community. Her service in education would later
9 include teaching at both public and private schools, to include J.Q. San Miguel
10 Elementary School (1986-1987), *Tamuning* Elementary School (1987-1988), and
11 Santa Barbara Catholic School (1989-1990). From 1988 to 1989, Mrs. Cubol had also
12 taught briefly at the Clark Air Base school system in the Republic of the Philippines.
13 Following her short tenure teaching at Santa Barbara Catholic School, Mrs. Cubol
14 joined the *Finegayan* Elementary School community in 1990; and

15 **WHEREAS**, as a mentor to many of her students and colleagues, Mrs. Cubol
16 was actively involved in learning opportunities outside of the classroom. She shared
17 her calligraphy skills for many years by writing countless Student of the Month
18 certificates; she directed drama productions for the ASPIRE program, as well as for
19 regular classes; and she worked with her colleagues to establish a school choir to
20 represent *Finegayan* Elementary School at various island-wide competitions; and

21 **WHEREAS**, after dedicating thirty (30) years of her time, talents, and personal
22 treasures to Guam’s youth and families, Mrs. Cubol retired from government service
23 as a GDOE public school educator on June 2, 2016; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the impact that Mrs. Cubol has had upon the thousands of
25 students she taught, helped, advised, counseled, and supported, in one way or another,
26 can be seen through the success stories of her former students who are actively

1 engaged in their respective communities as teachers, police officers, soldiers,
2 managers, and as countless other professionals; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in her thirty (30) years of service as a public school educator,
4 Mrs. Cubol provided excellent support to the principals and staff of the various
5 schools she was blessed to call her second family. Moreover, she helped to inspire
6 generations of Guamanians to believe in the value of education and hard work. It is
7 without question that Mrs. Cubol has helped to shape their future - and the future of
8 our entire island community; now therefore, be it

9 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
10 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
11 of Guam, recognize, commend, and congratulate Mrs. Cristina E. Carlos Cubol on the
12 occasion of her retirement from the Guam Department of Education; and does further
13 express a sincere *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to her for dedicating thirty (30)
14 years of her life to building the futures of the people of Guam; and be it further


