1           **WHEREAS**, Fina attended Cathedral Grade School, Bishop Baumgartner  
2 Memorial School, and the Academy of Our Lady of Guam. She received her Bachelor’s  
3 degree in Elementary Education from the University of Hawaii at Manoa in 2004; and  
4 later, she received her Master’s degree in Counseling from the University of Guam in  
5 2010; and

6           **WHEREAS**, Fina has been an educator and advocate for her students for the past  
7 twelve (12) years; and she has taught a variety of grade levels in both Hawaii and Guam.  
8 She was inspired to become a teacher by her father, David, who himself is an educator;

10           **WHEREAS**, other than educating our youth, Fina has volunteered her time and  
11 efforts to serving the community with organizations such as, *I Famagu’on-ta*, the  
12 Salvation Army, and I Recycle; and

13           **WHEREAS**, over the years, Fina has received numerous certificates and awards;  
14 and she has contributed immensely to the curriculum development and educational  
15 assessments with the Guam Department of Education; and

16           **WHEREAS**, for Fina, it was an astounding and exciting moment to receive this  
17 prominent Award, which serves as a reflection of the multifaceted efforts of our  
18 educators and the island community in engaging our students in lifelong critical thinking  
19 and problem solving; and
