Relative to congratulating Taiwan, officially the Republic of China, on the occasion of the One Hundred Fifth (105th) “Double Tenth National Day”; and to further recognizing and commending the Taiwanese and Chinese Community of Guam for its invaluable contributions to Guam, and for its efforts in fostering a closer relationship with the people of Guam.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, on October 10, 2016, the people of Taiwan will celebrate the One
4 Hundred Fifth (105th) “Double Tenth National Day” of the establishment of the

1 Republic of China, a day that commemorates the triumph over the Ching Dynasty, and
2 the beginning of the Republic of China under the leadership of Dr. Sun Yat-Sen; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam congratulate Taiwan on having Dr. Tsai Ing-
4 Wen elected as the first female President in its history on January 16, 2016 and having
5 accomplished its third transition of political power through a peaceful electoral
6 process; and

7 **WHEREAS**, since 1973, the people of Guam have shared a special Sister-City
8 bond with the people of Taipei City that has benefited Guam and Taiwan through
9 cultural exchanges and economic investments; and

10 **WHEREAS**, this relationship, which has lasted for more than four (4) decades,
11 has translated into millions of dollars in investments on Guam, for which the people of
12 Guam are obliged; and

13 **WHEREAS**, around fifty thousand (50,000) visitors from Taiwan came to
14 Guam last fiscal year—representing the third (3rd) largest number of tourists to visit
15 Guam, following Japan and Korea—fostering the growth of tourism, which is one of
16 Guam’s primary industries; and

17 **WHEREAS**, prior to 2009, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* had adopted Legislative
18 Resolutions commending the efforts of Taiwan to promote World Health and the
19 endorsement of Taiwan to observer status in the World Health Assembly, the supreme
20 governing body of the United Nations World Health Organization; as well as to
21 support the inclusion of Taiwan, officially the Republic of China, in the United
22 Nations Specialized Agencies, such as the International Civil Aviation Organization
23 (ICAO) and the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change
24 (UNFCCC); and

1 **WHEREAS**, on April 29, 2009, Taiwan was invited to take part as an observer
2 in the World Health Assembly; and in September of 2013, Taiwan’s delegation was
3 invited by the President of the ICAO Council, Mr. Robert Gonzalez, to attend the
4 Thirty-eighth (38th) Assembly of the ICAO in Montreal, which are both major
5 breakthroughs for Taiwan’s persistent campaign for more active participation in
6 international activities; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Taiwanese and Chinese Community of Guam, including the
8 Taiwanese Business Association of Guam, the United Chinese Association of Guam,
9 the Chinese Chamber of Commerce of Guam, and the Chinese Ladies Association of
10 Guam, continue to be at the forefront of various worthwhile community projects
11 throughout Guam, all of which the people of Guam are most appreciative for; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam, both from the government and the private
13 sectors, recognize the continued humanitarian efforts, determination, commitments
14 and labor that the various Taiwanese and Chinese organizations contribute to Guam
15 and its residents; now therefore, be it

16 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’Trentai Tres Na*
17 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
18 of Guam, congratulate Taiwan, officially the Republic of China, on the occasion of the
19 One Hundred Fifth (105th) “Double Tenth National Day,” and recognize and
20 commend the Taiwanese and Chinese Community of Guam for its many invaluable
21 contributions to Guam; and does further extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu’os Ma’åse’* to
22 the Taiwanese and Chinese Community of Guam for its efforts in fostering a closer
23 relationship with the people of Guam; and be it further

24 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
25 certify, and Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the
26 same be thereafter transmitted to the Honorable Ken C. P. Hu, Director General of

1 Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in Guam; to Mr. Joseph Hsu, President of the
2 Taiwanese Business Association of Guam; Mr. Michael Randall, President of the
3 United Chinese Association of Guam; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, I
4 *Maga'låhen Guåhan.*
