1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS, Captain Thomas S. Masga, Deputy Marshal Supervisor - Judiciary of**  
4 **Guam, is now retiring from the government of Guam and celebrates his service and**

1 accomplishments with his four (4) wonderful children: Jude, Aaron, Aaleyah and Jared  
2 Masga; and

3       **WHEREAS**, Captain Masga graduated from George Washington High School,  
4 and later received his Associates of Science Degree in Criminal Science from the Guam  
5 Community College; and he has more than twenty-seven (27) years of experience in law  
6 enforcement. He graduated with the 29<sup>th</sup> Police Cycle in August 1989, and had served  
7 with the Guam Police Department for more than two (2) years before transferring to the  
8 Judiciary of Guam in August 1991, where he served as a Deputy Marshal II; and

9       **WHEREAS**, Captain Masga is an efficient individual who was involved with a  
10 multitude of trainings, to include: the Military Police Basic Course; Registered G.R. &  
11 Pistol Firearms; Firearms Qualification courses; Substance Abuse Awareness;  
12 Investigative Report Writing; Basic Life Support; Drug Identification; Incident Response  
13 to Terrorist Bombings Awareness; Monadnock Expandable Baton (MEB) Basic Course;  
14 OCAT Basic Course; Public Safety Response Sampling Techniques & Guidelines  
15 Technical Level; WMD Tactical Operators Course; Dignitary Protection Training;  
16 Judicious Use of Deadly Force; Prevention & Response to Suicide Bombing Incidents;  
17 Protective/Threat Investigations Training; Pharmaceutical Diversion Training; and  
18 Occupancy Emergency Plan Training; and

19       **WHEREAS**, Captain Masga has received numerous Letters of Appreciation and  
20 Commendations, such as: a Letter of Commendation - Grand Opening of the Guam  
21 Judicial Center (1991); a Letter of Appreciation for his participation in the Guam Judicial  
22 Choir (1994); a Letter of Appreciation for the Apprehension of an Escaped Prisoner  
23 (2004); a Certificate of Nomination for “Supervisor of the Year” (2006-2007); a  
24 Certificate of Appreciation for Career Day at J.P. Torres Alternative School; a Letter of  
25 Commendation – Uniform Enforcement of Foreign Judgements Act (2015); and a  
26 Certificate of Recognition for Supervisor of the Year (2015); and

1           **WHEREAS**, prior to his public service with the government of Guam, Captain  
2 Masga joined the 368<sup>th</sup> Military Police Company and served as a Military Policeman.  
3 Upon completion of his training, he was certified as a Military Policeman and graduated  
4 with honors. His duties included the supervision of up to fourteen (14) personnel,  
5 conducting Military Police patrols, supervising traffic safety activity, riot and crowd  
6 control, preparing reports, assigning duties, and trainings and procedures. Captain Masga  
7 was later detailed to the 4960<sup>th</sup> Military Police School, Guam, as a certified instructor,  
8 where he taught several Military Police cycles before returning to the 368<sup>th</sup> Military  
9 Police Company; and

10           **WHEREAS**, in February 2004, Captain Masga transferred to the Guam Air  
11 National Guard 254<sup>th</sup> Security Forces Squadron as a founding member of this new unit.  
12 He volunteered to attend his third (3<sup>rd</sup>) law enforcement academy at Lackland Air Force  
13 Base, Texas. Upon his return, he was tasked to serve as a team leader and as an instructor  
14 for various law enforcement topics for his unit. Captain Masga deployed several times in  
15 support of the War on Terrorism; and was also deployed to Louisiana in a humanitarian  
16 mission to support the survivors and victims in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina. He  
17 retired in June 2007 after twenty-one (21) years of dedicated and selfless service; and

18           **WHEREAS**, during his law enforcement career with the Judiciary of Guam,  
19 Captain Masga was promoted to the position of Deputy Marshal III in September 1995;  
20 and with his hard work and dedication, he was promoted to Deputy Marshal Supervisor  
21 in September 1996; and

22           **WHEREAS**, after more than twenty-seven (27) years of public service, Captain  
23 Masga will now enjoy his retirement and looks forward to spending more quality time  
24 with his children and family; now therefore, be it
