3 **WHEREAS**, Captain Manglona graduated from George Washington High
4 School, and later received his Associates of Science Degree in Criminal Science. He
5 began his government of Guam career with the Judiciary of Guam in August 1982
6 serving as a Court Security Officer I; and in October 1984, he became a Deputy
7 Marshal II. With his hard work and dedication, he was promoted to the position of
8 Deputy Marshal III in February 1992; and he was later promoted to Deputy Marshal
9 Supervisor in September 1996, and has since held this position; he now leaves the
10 Guam Judiciary with more than thirty-four (34) years of experience in law
11 enforcement; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Captain Manglona is an efficient individual who was involved
13 with a multitude of trainings, to include: the 32nd Police Cycle (1992); Registered G.R.
14 & Pistol Firearms; the U.S. Marshals Service Restraints & Practical Pistol courses;

19 to Suicide Bombing Incidents; M-16 Long Arms Qualification Courses; and numerous
