1           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo married Rosario “Charo”  
2 Castro Calvo, who was his loving wife for forty-nine (49) years; and

3           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo and Mrs. Rosario Calvo  
4 shared their love with their children and in-laws: Veronica “Ronnie” Calvo and Steven  
5 Perez; Jacqueline M. Calvo and Christopher Anderson; Eduardo John and Therese  
6 Guzman Calvo; Frances Ann Calvo; Robert P. and Delta Salas; Veronica “Vera”  
7 Lopez; Big John Calvo and Paulette Saure; and Thomas J. Calvo, Jr. and Faith San  
8 Nicolas; and

9           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo’s love for his children  
10 extended unto his grandchildren: Cole Thomas, Christian, Kyle Jerome, Liam,  
11 Joakino, Sophia, Daniella Rose, †Tori, Robert II and Tess, Randy, Ashley and  
12 Morgan, Chantalee, Massi, Camryn and Thomas III; and

13           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo was a product of Guam’s  
14 elementary and junior high schools before attending Father Dueñas Memorial High  
15 School; and

16           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo was deeply involved with  
17 his family’s business at Calvo’s Enterprises, the parent company of a conglomerate of  
18 Calvo businesses; and

19           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo was the Chairman of  
20 Market Wholesale, and held director positions in various businesses, to include,  
21 Calvo’s Insurance Underwriters, Inc., and Pepsi Cola Bottling Company; and he was a  
22 one-third owner of the Bank of Saipan and was a member of the Board of Directors;  
23 and

24           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo owns and operates  
25 commercial buildings; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo, together with his children,  
2 entered into various business ventures, including: Bestseller, a chain of bookstores on  
3 Guam and Saipan; and Cup & Saucer, a gourmet bakery and coffee shop that fall  
4 under the umbrella of Jake and Associates, Inc.; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo served as a member of the Guam  
6 Election Commission for twenty (20) years; and he served as a member of the Guam  
7 Visitors Bureau Board of Directors from 1978 to 1982; and again in 2005; and

8           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo has served in many  
9 fraternal, civic and business associations, to include: Past Chairman of the Cathedral-  
10 Basilica Finance Council; Past Chairman of the Finance Council of the Catholic  
11 Cemeteries; Member of the Knights of Columbus; Charter member of the Guam  
12 Junior Chamber of Commerce; Sir Knight of Saint Sylvester; and he was an Elks  
13 Lodge member and former member of the Guam Lions Club; and

14           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo was an active member of  
15 the Board of Directors of the University of Guam Endowment Foundation, and under  
16 his leadership and through great family and community values, he helped to secure a  
17 Calvo’s Enterprises donation to the UOG Endowment Foundation in support of the  
18 University’s Sixtieth (60<sup>th</sup>) Year Anniversary; and in turn the Board of Trustees  
19 renamed the UOG Fieldhouse to the University of Guam Calvo Fieldhouse; and

20           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo will be greatly missed by  
21 his family and friends for his great spirit and nature in caring for all those that he had  
22 met; and

23           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo was called to his eternal  
24 reward on March 22, 2015, at the age of seventy-four (74); now therefore, be it

25           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’Trentai Tres Na*  
26 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people


1 of Guam, recognize and honor the late Thomas “Jerry” McDonald Calvo; and does


