**Relative to recognizing the Judiciary of Guam for its continued concerted efforts in addressing the serious issues of bullying and violence that affect youth and families in our community and schools, and on the observance of “Guam Bullying Prevention Month,” during the month of October 2016, with the theme of “Promoting Kindness and Respect on Social Media.”**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***  
3           **WHEREAS, *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* hereby recognizes**  
4 **that bullying prevention is essential in a close-knit, island community such as Guam;**  
5 **and**

6           **WHEREAS**, to foster positive behaviors and attitudes among Guam’s youth  
7 and families that stifle bullying, cyber-bullying, sexting, youth violence, and related  
8 issues, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* has joined the efforts that have been placed into motion  
9 by the Judiciary of Guam and the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) since 2008  
10 to provide law-related education to school students, school staff, parents, and the  
11 community; and

12           **WHEREAS**, through this collaboration, the Judiciary of Guam continues to  
13 conduct outreach and training in bullying prevention to public and private schools,  
14 and to the whole community; and

15           **WHEREAS**, the anti-bullying campaign themes of “**BASTA** (Bullying Affects  
16 Students, Teachers and All)” and “**DUO**: Do Unto Others – A Partnership Against  
17 Bullying” were created to inspire, educate and encourage youth and families to live by  
18 the “Golden Rule” to treat others with the respect and kindness we each deserve; and

19           **WHEREAS**, Guam joins a nationwide and even worldwide movement to send  
20 a unified message of support, hope and unity to youth that they are not alone, and that  
21 our communities support bullying prevention in schools, communities and online; and

22           **WHEREAS**, this year, the Judiciary of Guam has established the theme of  
23 “Promoting Kindness and Respect on Social Media” for the occasion, recognizing the  
24 amount of time spent online and the significance of social media in our lives, and  
25 reflecting on the need to interact with everyone in the ever-growing cyberworld with  
26 kindness and respect; and the Judicial Council on behalf of the Judiciary of Guam asks  
27 the people of Guam to use this occasion to join the movement to spread the local and  
28 national messages of “*Promoting Kindness and Respect on Social Media*” and  
29 “*Together Against Bullying – United for Kindness, Acceptance and Inclusion*”; and to  
30 participate in Unity Day by wearing orange on Wednesday, October 19, 2016; and *I*  
31 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the Judiciary of Guam pledge their continual support to

32 promote bullying prevention in the workplace and in the community; now therefore,  
33 be it

34 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*  
35 *Lihselaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihselaturan Guåhan* and the  
36 people of Guam, recognize the Judiciary of Guam for its concerted efforts in  
37 addressing the serious issue of bullying and violence that affect youth and families on  
38 Guam, and on the observance of “Guam Bullying Prevention Month,” during the  
39 month of October 2016, with the theme of “Promoting Kindness and Respect on  
40 Social Media”; and be it further

41 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules  
42 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
