1           BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I  
2    ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

1           **WHEREAS**, drug, tobacco and alcohol abuse have destructive ramifications on the  
2 community, most especially on families and our youth who have endured firsthand the  
3 harmful effects of this widespread epidemic. As an island community, we value the health  
4 and safety of our residents. Today, we face many challenges as we try to protect our loved  
5 ones from the ongoing battle against substance abuse; and

6           **WHEREAS**, the “*Red Ribbon Campaign*” began in 1985 after drug traffickers in  
7 Mexico City murdered Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) agent Enrique “Kiki”  
8 Camarena. His friends and neighbors wore red badges of satin signifying their utmost  
9 respect for his courage, and his honorable and ultimate sacrifice. The mission of the “*Red*  
10 *Ribbon Campaign*” is to present a unified and visible commitment toward the creation of  
11 a “Drug-Free America”; and

12           **WHEREAS**, recognizing the seriousness of this threat, the National Family  
13 Partnership initiated the first “*Red Ribbon Campaign*” in 1986. This grassroots effort  
14 emphasized education and the importance of teaching about drug, alcohol and tobacco  
15 prevention to our youth, families, and communities in every corner of the country; and

16           **WHEREAS**, Guam’s participation in this national effort was started in 1988 by the  
17 *Dededo* Drug-Free Organization (now known as Youth for Youth LIVE! Guam). The 2016  
18 “*Red Ribbon Campaign*” Committee is comprised of representatives from federal and local  
19 government agencies; the military; non-profit organizations; and the Guam Chamber of  
20 Commerce; and

21           **WHEREAS**, the 2016 “*Red Ribbon Campaign*” theme is: “*YOLO. Be Drug Free!*”  
22 *#YOUONLYLIVEONCE*, and some of this year’s activities include: a school gate/wall  
23 decorating contest; a Red Ribbon Wave in *Hagåtña*; a Community Outreach at the  
24 Micronesia Mall; a “Say Boo to Drugs” community event; school presentations; and  
25 numerous print, television, and radio media events; and

26           **WHEREAS**, education and outreach activities are critical weapons in the  
27 community’s effort to fight substance abuse. It is the goal of the “*Red Ribbon Campaign*”  
28 Committee to involve families, schools, businesses, churches, law enforcement agencies

1 and service organizations to establish an atmosphere that supports awareness and education  
2 that will help to prevent alcohol, tobacco and illegal drug use, and related activities; and

3 **WHEREAS**, on the occasion of the 2016 “*Red Ribbon Month*” during October  
4 2016, *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* encourages the residents of Guam to  
5 consider ways to participate in this influential effort. As we build upon the successes of the  
6 past, we strengthen the Guam of tomorrow; and with strong determination and leadership,  
7 we must aim to protect our community from the preventable dangers of alcohol, tobacco  
8 and drug abuse; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the 2016 “*Red Ribbon Campaign*” activities are being made possible  
10 by the “*Red Ribbon Campaign*” Committee; and the ongoing awareness efforts will  
11 concentrate on promoting healthy choices and lifestyles that are drug, tobacco, alcohol, and  
12 violence-free; now therefore, be it

13 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan*  
14 *Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam,  
15 recognize and commend the members of the 2016 “*Red Ribbon Campaign*” Committee for  
16 their outstanding commitment and leadership in taking a pro-active stance against drug,  
17 tobacco and alcohol abuse on the occasion of “*Red Ribbon Month*” during the month of  
18 October 2016, and extends *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to these individuals and  
19 organizations for the significant contributions they have made, and continue to make, to  
20 eliminate drug, tobacco and alcohol abuse on Guam; and does further encourage the people  
21 of Guam to embrace this year’s 2016 “*Red Ribbon Campaign*” theme: “*YOLO. Be Drug*  
22 *Free!*” #*YOUONLYLIVEONCE*, and to wear a red ribbon during “*National Red Ribbon*

25 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules  
26 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the  
27 same be thereafter transmitted to the “*Red Ribbon Campaign*” Committee; and to the  
28 Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*.
