3 **WHEREAS,** Attorney Pablo Aglubat has dedicated twenty-four (24) years of
4 his life in service to the people of Guam by providing for our island community in a
5 number of different capacities; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Attorney Pablo Aglubat is the son of †Pablo Aglubat and †Rita
2 Champaco Manalisay Aglubat; and is the fifth (5th) child of nine (9) children; and his
3 parents-in-law are †Speaker Franklin Arceo Quitugua and †Julia Siguenza Quitugua;
4 and

5 **WHEREAS**, Attorney Pablo Aglubat is married to Clare Quitugua Aglubat;
6 and they have seven (7) children - Paul, Alison, Joshua, Anne, a daughter-in-law,
7 Abigail, and three (3) who are in heaven. Their daughter, Alison, is a Carmelite nun at
8 the Carmelite Monastery in New Jersey, and is better known as Sister Shoshanna
9 Yafah; their son, Joshua, is a mathematics teacher at Oceanview Middle School,
10 Guam; and their daughter, Anne, is a Senior at George Washington High School,
11 Guam; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Attorney Aglubat and his lovely wife, Clare, take joy in their two
13 (2) grandchildren, Elizabeth and James; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Attorney Pablo Aglubat is a 1974 graduate of George Washington
15 High School. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in Economics from the
16 University of Oregon in 1978; and in 1983, he received his Juris Doctorate from the
17 University of Oregon School of Law; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Attorney Aglubat started his government service working as a
19 Law Clerk at the Superior Court of Guam, serving from January to July of 1984; and
20 from January to April of 1985, he served as a Special Assistant to the Governor's
21 Legal Counsel; and

22 **WHEREAS**, from August 1992 to December 1993, Pablo Aglubat served as a
23 Revenue Agent IV at the Tax Enforcement Division of the Department of Revenue
24 and Taxation; and from December 1993 to February 1994, he served as an Attorney
25 IV at the Attorney General's Office; and

1 **WHEREAS**, from February 1994 to October 2016, Attorney Pablo Aglubat
2 then served as an Attorney IV at the Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC);
3 and

4 **WHEREAS**, the Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC) exists to
5 provide effective legal assistance to those who are unable to afford private
6 counsel, thereby ensuring equal protection of their lawful rights in accordance
7 with prescribed ethics, laws, rules and regulations; and

8 **WHEREAS**, through the tireless efforts and sacrifices of exemplary
9 members of our community such as Attorney Pablo M. Aglubat, who sets an
10 extraordinary example of public service, we are given a great opportunity to
11 pass on this legacy of serving one another; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Attorney Pablo Aglubat has been a member of numerous Bar
13 Associations, such as the Oregon State Bar, the U.S. District Court of Guam, the
14 Ninth (9th) Circuit Court of Appeals, and the Guam Bar Association; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Attorney Pablo Aglubat's areas of specialty are: Criminal
16 Defense, Probate Law, Bankruptcy, Family Law, Real Estate, Wills and Estate
17 Planning, Taxation, and Civil Litigation; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Guam and her people are fortunate to have someone with the
19 passion of hard-working, committed individuals such as Attorney Aglubat, who
20 professionally and voluntarily give of their time and talents to make our island
21 community a better place for all who call Guam home; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Attorney Aglubat is always ready and willing to serve on the
23 front lines of battle for the island's less fortunate—a testament to his inherent sense of
24 justice for all, regardless of social status; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Pablo has spent countless hours providing legal advice and
2 appearing in courtrooms in defense of his clients, whose lives have undoubtedly
3 been changed as a result of Attorney Aglubat’s dedicated service to them; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Attorney Aglubat adheres to “Gideon’s Promise” as the
5 primary engine of change in the criminal justice system; and thus the primary focus
6 for all public defenders’ efforts. As a devout Catholic and an active member of the
7 Neocatechumenal Way, *Agaña* community, Attorney Aglubat volunteers his time
8 serving as a church youth leader; and

9 **WHEREAS**, centered on his religious belief, Attorney Aglubat does not
10 underestimate the importance of giving his clients respect and a sense of their
11 deep humanity during the most trying time of their lives; and

12 **WHEREAS**, as an attorney, Mr. Aglubat has worked tirelessly to transform
13 the belief that legal affairs affect both the larger criminal justice system and
14 communities by implementing best practices while driving systemic reform; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Attorney Aglubat has learned to balance work and family
16 time; and he enjoys various hobbies, such as: reading; jogging; going to the
17 beach; and doing yard work, which he considers physical therapy; and

18 **WHEREAS**, after twenty-four (24) years of public service, Attorney
19 Aglubat is retiring from the Government of Guam - Public Defender Service
20 Corporation, and beginning a new chapter in his life; now therefore, be it
