1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS, on November 10, 1775, our nation's leaders initiated the Continental**  
4 **Marines, beginning a rich heritage of successfully defending our country and its citizens;**  
5 **and**

1           **WHEREAS**, the Continental Marines, which became the United States Marine  
2 Corps, was established as the Revolutionary War was ongoing, and was commanded by  
3 Major Samuel Nicholas; and

4           **WHEREAS**, the U.S. Marine Corps has forged a noble history in defending the  
5 nation with honor and distinction in all its many wars and armed conflicts, most notably in  
6 the Civil War, World War I, World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, Panama,  
7 Grenada, the Persian Gulf War, our peace mission in East Timor, and the Global War on  
8 Terrorism (Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom); and

9           **WHEREAS**, the U.S. Marines Corps landed on Guam on July 21, 1944 (now  
10 observed as Guam’s Liberation Day), with the Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Marine Division and the First  
11 (1<sup>st</sup>) Provisional Marine Brigade playing a major role in liberating Guam from enemy  
12 occupation in World War II; and on August 10, 1944, Guam was declared secure, making  
13 the people of Guam forever grateful to the U.S. Marine Corps for its part in the island’s  
14 liberation so many years ago; and

15           **WHEREAS**, since the end of World War II, thousands of Guam’s men and women  
16 have joined the U.S. Marine Corps and have distinguished themselves for their valor and  
17 dedication, some of whom have sacrificed their lives in wars and conflicts around the  
18 world. In the fall of 2008, the Marine Corps Activity Guam (MCAG) was formed; and  
19 since MCAG’s inception they have been responsible for coordinating with local entities of  
20 the U.S. Department of Defense, other U.S. government agencies, and the government of  
21 Guam and the CNMI; and

22           **WHEREAS**, this Two Hundred Forty-First (241<sup>st</sup>) Year Anniversary  
23 commemorates the initial establishment of the U.S. Marine Corps; and honors its warriors,  
24 families, and civilians, who are constantly trying to achieve a level of supremacy in valor  
25 and service that is truly *Semper Fidelis* (Always Faithful); and

26           **WHEREAS**, the principles of democracy and freedom, as documented in the  
27 Constitution of the United States, are what the U.S. Marine Corps stands prepared to shield

1 and defend for our citizens; and the U.S. Marine Corps has continued its tradition of  
2 innovation to meet the challenges of an ever changing environment; now therefore, be it

3 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan*  
4 *Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam,  
5 recognize and honor the men and women of the United States Marine Corps on the  
6 celebration of the U.S. Marine Corps' Two Hundred Forty-First (241<sup>st</sup>) Year Anniversary  
7 on November 10, 2016, and commend them for their selfless contributions of outstanding  
8 service to Guam and the nation in the defense of freedom for over two (2) centuries; and  
9 does further extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to the U.S. Marine Corps and its  
10 dedicated members, active and retired, for their continued service to our island and country;  
11 and be it further

12 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules  
13 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the
