Quintanilla, fondly known as “Dinga,” Vice Mayor of *Agat*, for his many outstanding achievements and his dedication to serving Guam and its people; and to further extending sincere and humble condolences to his family on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2           ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS,** the late Honorable Vice Mayor Agustin G. Quintanilla was born  
4           on August 8, 1962, in the village of *Agat*; and he was called to his eternal reward on  
5           March 19, 2015, at the age of fifty-two (52); and

1           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vice Mayor Agustin G. Quintanilla is the son  
2 of †Jesus Taitano Quintanilla and †Remedios Guzman Quintanilla; and

3           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vice Mayor Agustin G. Quintanilla was  
4 blessed with three (3) daughters: Nikita, a student of Southern High School; and  
5 twins, Alianna and Julianna, students of Oceanview Middle School; and

6           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vice Mayor Agustin G. Quintanilla graduated  
7 from the Guam Community College, and he then began his professional career  
8 working at the U.S. Navy Guam Ship Repair Facility (SRF), and at the U.S. Navy  
9 Public Works Center as a Welder; and he had also worked at Raytheon as a Structural  
10 Leader; and worked at DZSP as a Combination Welder; and

11           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vice Mayor Agustin G. Quintanilla was then  
12 appointed and subsequently elected to serve as the Vice Mayor of the village of *Agat*,  
13 where his skills and creativity were utilized to help the community advance and  
14 prosper; and

15           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vice Mayor Agustin G. Quintanilla was very  
16 active in the community, serving as a member of the *Agat* Municipal Planning  
17 Council, from 1996 to the present; as the Vice President of the *Agat* Santa Ana  
18 Rancheros Association, from 2004 to the present; as a member and Vice President of  
19 the Marcial Sablan Elementary School Parent Teachers Association (PTA), from 2005  
20 to 2006; as the Manager of the *Agat* Cardinals Baseball Team, from 2012 to the  
21 present; and he had also served as a member of the Western Visayas College of  
22 Science & Technology (WBCST) Association-Guam Chapter; and

23           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vice Mayor Agustin Quintanilla was also an  
24 active parishioner of the Mount Carmel and Santa Ana Church, and he was often  
25 found behind the scenes cooking, roasting, and baking for many church activities, as

1 well as for community events and fiestas. He had always enjoyed cooking and  
2 building, utilizing natural resources; and

3 **WHEREAS**, some of the achievements of late Honorable Vice Mayor Agustin  
4 G. Quintanilla include working on projects, such as: “Operation Pacific Haven”;  
5 “Operation Tandem Thrust “99””; the building of the Santa Ana Chapel under the  
6 Santa Ana Association; the extension of the “*Sagan Bisita*” pavilion; and the building  
7 of the *Agat* village Liberation Day float, which garnered third (3<sup>rd</sup>) place in 2009 and  
8 second (2<sup>nd</sup>) place in 2010; and

9 **WHEREAS**, in celebration of *Chamorro* Month and in support of the military  
10 sister-village, the late Honorable Vice Mayor Agustin G. Quintanilla fabricated  
11 *Chamorro* huts for display at the Main Navy Exchange; and for the Naval Station and  
12 *Agaña* McDonalds Restaurants; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vice Mayor Agustin G. Quintanilla  
14 constructed benches for the *Agat* Gym and the baseball field dugout house. He had  
15 also received numerous awards and earned the appreciation of Southern High School,  
16 Oceanview Middle School, Marcial Sablan Elementary School, Mount Carmel  
17 School, Notre Dame High School, the Pacific Island Jurisdiction AIDS Action Group,  
18 the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS), and others; and


19 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Agustin G. Quintanilla will always be fondly  
20 remembered for his hard work, dedication, and selfless efforts; and for his humble and  
21 caring heart that was always concerned for the well being of the family he loved and  
22 the community he so devotedly served; now therefore, be it
