3 **WHEREAS,** the late Mr. John F. Taitano has dedicated twenty-six (26) years
4 of his life in service with the government of Guam, while working at the Guam Police
5 Department. He is the son of †Antonio Castro Taitano, †Mariano Pangelinan

1 Mendiola, and Helen Gumataotao Mendiola. He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Cynthia
2 Dumlao-Taitano; his children, †Keith, Renea, Natalie, Edward, Brittany, Troy, and
3 Madison; and his wonderful grandchildren; and

4 **WHEREAS**, in June of 1989, John began his government of Guam career at
5 the Guam Police Department, serving as an Auxiliary Worker; and through hard work
6 and dedication, he continued to work his way up the ranks, and he was later promoted
7 to Property Control Officer in April of 2005, where he had maintained his diligent
8 service while working in this position; and

9 **WHEREAS**, throughout his years of service at the Guam Police Department,
10 Mr. Taitano has been applauded for the outstanding performance of his duties; and in
11 October of 1993, he received a Certificate of Commendation; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in November of 1994, John received a Letter of Commendation
13 for his dedication, perseverance and great endeavor to the Department; and in
14 December of the same year, he received Letters of Appreciation for his hard work and
15 dedication to duty, and for his continuous professionalism; and

16 **WHEREAS**, in May of 1995, Mr. Taitano received the Distinguished Award
17 for his loyalty, dedication and outstanding performance; and again in April of 1996,
18 he received the Distinguished Award for his superior performance; and in May of
19 1996, he received a Letter of Appreciation for his exemplary performance; and

20 **WHEREAS**, in January of 1998 and May of 1999, John received Letters of
21 Commendation and a Certificate of Appreciation for his professionalism, and for
22 promoting peace and tranquility in the community; and

23 **WHEREAS**, in May of 2003 and in 2006, John received the Distinguished
24 Service Award for loyalty, dedication and outstanding performance; and in May of
25 2005, he received the Distinguished Service Award from Governor Felix Camacho for

1 his supportive, friendly and compassionate deeds to improve and make a positive
2 impact on the island of Guam; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in 2004, John received the “Civilian of the Year” Award for his
4 outstanding duty with the Guam Police Department; and he has received superior
5 performance ratings since then; now therefore, be it

8 of Guam, recognize and memorialize the late Mr. John F. Taitano for his twenty-six
