1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS,** it is through volunteerism and community service that our island
4 perpetuates the idea of *Inafa'maolek* and the definition of community; and

1 **WHEREAS**, it is in the tireless efforts and commitment of volunteers that
2 make a real and lasting change for our island’s people; and

3 **WHEREAS**, “National Volunteer Week” was created in 1974 when President
4 Nixon signed an executive order to establish the week as an annual celebration of
5 volunteering; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Act formally launched AmeriCorps, a network of national
7 service programs that engage Americans in intensive service to meet the nation’s
8 critical needs in education, environmental stewardship, economic opportunity, disaster
9 preparedness, healthy futures, assistance to veterans and military families, and
10 capacity building in the recruitment and retention of volunteers, and volunteer
11 management; and

12 **WHEREAS**, “National Volunteer Week” reflects the power that volunteers
13 have to “Celebrate Service” and to encourage those they help and motivate others to
14 serve; and to celebrate the noble and selfless act of volunteerism; and

15 **WHEREAS**, our island community will observe the 2015 “National Volunteer
16 Week” from April 14 to April 18, 2015, with the Office of *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*, in
17 the promotion of community outreach and civic engagement; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the “National Volunteer Week” service projects will include:
19 AmeriCorps Team Building and Training; Thank-A-Volunteer; AmeriCorps Cares and
20 Distribution of “Get Well Cards”; AmeriCorps Reads; AmeriCorps Recruitment,
21 Retention, and Volunteer Management, and the Governor’s Recognition Award; an
22 AmeriCorps tour of medicinal fruits and vegetables at *Amot* Farm; and AmeriCorps
23 Youth Disaster Preparedness; now therefore, be it

24 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
25 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
26 of Guam, commend the Serve Guam! Commission (SGC), and the members of the


