- 4 protecting the rights, freedom and justice of all Americans; and

WHEREAS, "Law Day" has been designated as a remarkable annual occasion for the recognition and celebration of our nation's great heritage of liberty, justice and equality under the law; and

WHEREAS, a viable and lively democracy requires the understanding of the nature and basis of the freedom that every American citizen enjoys today, and the acknowledgment of the tremendous responsibility each individual has in the representation of these freedoms; and

WHEREAS, all American citizens, young and old, should understand their individual rights and responsibilities under the law to become effective and active participants in our nation's civil life, and positive contributors in society; and

WHEREAS, in 1958, "Law Day" was established and proclaimed by President Dwight D. Eisenhower; and it was reaffirmed through a Joint Resolution by the Members of the U.S. Congress in 1961; and

WHEREAS, "Law Day" is celebrated annually on May 1<sup>st</sup> as a special day of celebration by the people of Guam and the nation, to join in the appreciation of every American citizen's liberties, and to provide a unique time for reflection and dedication of the ideals of equality and justice for all under the laws of the land; and

WHEREAS, the theme of "Law Week 2015" is, "Magna Carta: Symbol of Freedom Under Law." The Magna Carta dates back eight hundred years and is principally recognized as being the first document in which it was asserted that power is derived from the people rather than from the king, perhaps more than any other document in human history; and the Magna Carta has come to embody a simple but enduring truth: that no one, no matter how powerful, is above the law; and

WHEREAS, in the eight centuries that have elapsed since the Magna Carta was sealed in 1215, it has taken root as an international symbol of the rule of law and as an inspiration for the many basic rights Americans hold dear today; and

WHEREAS, "Law Week 2015" will provide the people of Guam and the legal community with a chance to understand and appreciate the many challenges and opportunities that have confronted the legal community today, and to consider the transformation of the justice system and the many programs that continue to support the island community; and

WHEREAS, during the course of "Law Week 2015," and through the collective efforts of the Guam Bar Association, the Judiciary of Guam, and the U.S. District Court of Guam, numerous events and presentations have been scheduled that will highlight the activities and services available within Guam's legal community for the benefit of Guam's residents, to include: the State of Judiciary Address; the Swearing-in Ceremony for newly-admitted Guam Bar Members; the presentation of the *Hustisia* Award; Local and Federal Courthouse Tours; the Mock Trials by our island's youth; a Law Fair at the Micronesia Mall; seminars and demonstrations on various topics; the Judiciary of Guam's 5k Fun Run/Walk; and the Guam Bar Association's 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Charity Golf Tournament; now therefore, be it
