1 WHEREAS, each year, the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) also

2 recognizes the great and special impact made by outstanding small business owners,

- and honors the champions of America's entrepreneurs; and
- 4 WHEREAS, since 1991, at the invitation of the U.S. Small Business
- 5 Administration, the Guam Small Business Administration participated in the awards
- 6 competition in the state of Hawaii; specifically, the SBA "Small Business Person of
- 7 the Year" Award; and

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- 8 WHEREAS, each state winner would compete at the Regional IX Level
- 9 comprised of Hawaii, California, Arizona and Nevada. The regional winner would
- then compete at the National Level comprised of ten regions; and
- WHEREAS, the first awardee to represent Guam in Hawaii was William
- 12 Thomason, a Guam businessman who competed against the best entrepreneurs in
- 13 Hawaii; and although he was unsuccessful in garnering the regional award, he
- 14 represented Guam with so much enthusiasm that Guam was offered other
- opportunities in the regional SBA awards competition; and
- WHEREAS, it was good for Guam that these opportunities were afforded to
- 17 the Guam Small Business Administration in that each subsequent year it offered
- 18 expanded opportunities to recognize those who would champion the cause for certain
- 19 small business groups; and
- WHEREAS, the new award recognition programs included: Minority, Women
- 21 in Business, Veteran, Family-Owned, Home-Based, Financial Services, and Journalist
- of the Year; and
- WHEREAS, in 2000, the Guam Small Business Administration was given the
- 24 opportunity to have its own independent recognition program, breaking away from
- 25 direct competition with the fifty U.S. states; and

1 WHEREAS, Guam's "Small Business Person of the Year" Awardee was

2 invited to participate in the "National Small Business Week" celebration in

- 3 Washington, D.C., along with the winners from all fifty states; and
- 4 WHEREAS, in 2008, Guam established a milestone in the SBA Awards
- 5 Program when it recognized Gary Sung, Owner and Creative Director of Ideal
- 6 Advertising, as the first regional award winner of the 2008 SBA "Young Entrepreneur
- 7 Champion of the Year"; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in 2010, Guam produced a second regional award winner, Shana
- 9 Guzman, President of International Distributors, Inc., who won the 2010 SBA "Jeffrey
- 10 Butland Family-Owned Business of the Year" Award; and
- WHEREAS, for twenty-five years, the Guam Small Business Administration
- has solicited nominations from the public and private sector partners for successful
- 13 entrepreneurs and individuals who provide assistance or advocacy in the interest of
- small businesses; and
- WHEREAS, where sustainability is key, the Guam SBA Awards Program
- would not have been possible without the support of organizations, such as the Bank
- of Guam, the Chinese Chamber of Commerce of Guam, and other private individuals
- 18 who have successfully nominated those who have merited the awards throughout the
- 19 past twenty-five years; and
- WHEREAS, the winners of the annual SBA Awards are selected by a panel
- 21 consisting of the winners of the previous year, building a camaraderie amongst
