21 newborn infants, and the Gift Cart services on wheels to hospital rooms on the
22 different floors which provides items for the convenience of patients and guests; and

23 **WHEREAS**, having been employed in the government of Guam since January
24 1962, Mrs. Priscilla Muña has held various positions in different departments and
25 agencies within the government of Guam, to include the Department of Labor, where

1 at times she was detailed to serve as Acting Director, Deputy Director, and acting
2 department administrator for departmental programs; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Priscilla Muña received the “Governor’s Citation” on
4 December 7, 1988, from Governor Joseph Ada in recognition of her exemplary
5 performance, dedication and perseverance as a Public Service Employee; and

6 **WHEREAS**, in the years 1997 and 1998; and from the year 1999 to 2000, prior
7 to and after becoming the Association’s President, Mrs. Priscilla Muña chaired
8 various committees such as, Steering, Nomination, Volunteer of the Year Award,
9 Constitution and Bylaws, Parliamentarian, and the Skilled Nursing Unit’s annual
10 “Three King’s” social, gift giving and feeding for the patients, to include serving on
11 the Board of Directors on three different occasions; and she was the recipient of the
12 “Volunteer of the Year” Award for 2004; and

13 **WHEREAS**, during her tenure as President, the Association funded the first
14 Medical Transport Van that supplements the ambulance runs for patients to and from
15 the Guam Memorial Hospital and the Skilled Nursing Unit in *Barrigada*; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Priscilla Muña was involved through her leadership in the
17 success of the two (2) annual Charity Balls that were held during her respective terms,
18 and the Association was able to provide funding for several much-needed equipment
19 and supplies for the Guam Memorial Hospital; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Priscilla Muña is currently serving as a member of the Guam
21 Council of Women’s Clubs; and she is a member and past President of the YMLG
22 Ladies Auxiliary; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Priscilla Muña has used her God-given talent in providing
24 both financial and volunteer services to the community in numerous ways. She is
25 currently serving a third term as Regent for the Catholic Daughters of the Americas,
26 the largest Catholic women’s organization in the world. She is also past President and

1 current Vice-President for the Confraternity of Christian Mothers for the St. Jude
2 Parish, and is a current member of the St. Jude Church Bereavement Committee; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in March 2015, Mrs. Priscilla Muña was recognized as an
4 “Honoree” during Women’s History Month, sponsored by the First Lady of Guam
5 Christine Calvo; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Priscilla Muña is blessed with a very compassionate,
7 generous and caring family, to include her husband of fifty-five (55) years, Mr.
