1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN***

3           **WHEREAS,** Mariquita Santos Palacios has dedicated thirty-one (31) years of  
4 her life in faithful service to the government of Guam while working with the Guam  
5 Police Department. Mariquita was born on July 21, 1951; she is the daughter of †Leon  
6 Torres Palacios and †*Tan* Angela Santos Palacios, who was a Master *Suruhana*; and  
7 she is the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) child of seven (7) children; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Mariquita was baptized as a Catholic at Santa Barbara Church in  
2 *Dededo*; and she had attended Santa Barbara School from kindergarten through the  
3 eighth (8<sup>th</sup>) grade. She then attended *Dededo* Middle School and graduated from John  
4 F. Kennedy High School in 1971; and

5           **WHEREAS**, after graduation, Mariquita worked for nine (9) years in the  
6 private sector, at businesses such as the Town House Department Store and Gibson's  
7 Department Store; and

8           **WHEREAS**, in February 1986, Mariquita began her government of Guam  
9 career serving with the Guam Police Department as a Clerk II; and through hard work  
10 and dedication, she was later promoted to the position of Telephone Operator in  
11 December 1996, and has since then maintained this position. She had also worked in  
12 other divisions of the Department, such as Records & I.D., the Fiscal Section, and  
13 Tactical Operations; and

14           **WHEREAS**, throughout her years of government service with the Guam Police  
15 Department, Ms. Palacios has been applauded for her outstanding performance of  
16 duties; and in September 1986 and July 1987, she received Letters of Appreciation;  
17 and

18           **WHEREAS**, in May 1988, Mariquita received the Commanding Officer's  
19 Citation for her commitment and great endeavor to the Department. From June 1989  
20 through January 1998, she received numerous Certificates of Appreciation for her  
21 superb performance, support to duty, and for her continuous participation and  
22 professionalism; and

23           **WHEREAS**, in May 2003, Ms. Palacios received the "Distinguished Service  
24 Award" for her loyalty, dedication and outstanding achievements; and in May 2014,  
25 she was awarded with the "Meritorious Service Medal" for her admirable service and  
26 performance; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Mariquita has always been praised by her colleagues, and she  
2 feels that she too has been blessed with such exceptional supervisors and co-workers,  
3 both in uniform and civilian; and she considers them family and will continue to pray  
4 for them; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Palacios will be celebrating her retirement with her daughter,  
6 Theresa Ann Palacios; and her niece, Lori Jean Cruz. She says she plans to enjoy her  
7 retirement and continue to attend Mass at Santa Teresita Church, and every third  
8 Sunday at San Vicente Church; as well as spending some of her time visiting her  
9 mother and brothers at Guam Memorial Park Cemetery in *Barrigada*, having Sunday  
10 brunch, going to the movies, and window shopping; now therefore, be it

12 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os*
